Brief Project Description: The University of Wisconsin-Madison, in association with Madison Gas & Electric, is proposing to construct a new electrical switchgear building at the Walnut Street substation. The building would be constructed entirely within the boundary of the existing electrical substation. The three-story (47 foot tall) structure would not be occupied. Exterior walls would be constructed of insulated pre-cast concrete panels and have an exterior exit stair on the west side of the building.
