WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority of the City of Madison (the "CDA") is the owner of The Village on Park, located at 2200 South Park Street; and

WHEREAS, the CDA and Job Corps have negotiated terms and conditions of the lease of approximately 388 square feet of retail space within the Atrium at The Villager.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Development Authority of the City of Madison (the "Landlord") hereby authorizes the execution of a lease (the "Lease") between the CDA and Job Corps (the "Tenant") for office space within The Villager on the following terms and conditions:

- Premises:** 388 rentable square feet shown as 003A on the attached Exhibit
- Landlord:** Community Development Authority of the City of Madison
- Tenant:** Job Corp
- Use:** Office space for administrative purposes and community programs
- Initial Term and Base Rental Rate:** Term of One (1) year with the Tenant having the right to terminate for non-appropriation with 30 days notice to Landlord.

Base Rental Rate of \$500 per month. Rent shall escalate annually by three percent (3.0%) on the anniversary of the Lease Commencement Date.

Rental Rate shall be a full service gross rate including taxes, utilities, insurance and common area maintenance.
- Janitorial** Tenant is responsible for in-suite janitorial service
- Space Delivery** Landlord will deliver Leased Premises to Tenant in "As Is" condition.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Lease and to take such other actions as shall be necessary or desirable to accomplish the purposes of this resolution.
