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Dear Board of Public Works,

I oppose the use of City of Madison's police powers to establish a Regent Street assessment district at this time, given that the plans being proposed for Regent Street are substandard and non-compliant with Madison ordinance.

Residents and businesses should not be responsible for footing the bill for a street reconstruction project that fails to include all modes, as required under Complete Green Streets. The reconstructed street will fail to serve Regent Street residents who use those unserved modes, and fail to bring Regent Street businesses the customer traffic they deserve and may need.

Regent Street residents and businesses deserve better, for what they'll be paying in for the reconstruction, and they have good reason to refuse and legally contest the establishment of such an assessment district.
