SUMMARY:

At its meeting of March 2, 2011, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of the building addition located at 3010 Nob Hill Road. Appearing on behalf of the project was Dale Volkening, representing Phillips Distributing Corporation. Volkening presented the changes to the parking area, moving of the staff patio area to the landscaped area, changes to the bioretention area to prevent any standing water in the drainage swales, along with a review of the building elevations, materials and colors; the landscape architect has soften some of the edges of the parking lot to provide a more natural shape for the stormwater areas.

ACTION:

On a motion by Slayton, seconded by O'Kroley, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL**. The motion was passed on a vote of (7-0).
