





LETTER OF INTENT - REVISED

Name of Project: Boys and Girls Club Allied Family Center Parking Lot and Basketball Court Relocation

<u>Project Description</u>: The City of Madison will build a parking lot and relocate a basketball court on City of Madison land located at 4701 Jenewein Road. The City will lease the parking lot to the BGC who will use it in conjunction with a 21,200 sq. ft. Family Center to be built at 2619 Jenewein Rd in the City of Fitchburg.

<u>Construction Schedule</u>: Construction of the parking lot and basketball court is expected to begin in August 2005 and completed in September 2005. BGC hopes to begin construction of the Family Center in June and be complete in February 2006.

<u>Total Gross Square Footage</u>: The parking lot and basketball court will be 26,950 square feet.

<u>Number of Employees for Project</u>: The BGC Family Center is expected to be staffed daily by 4 full time and 12 part time employees. BGC Family Center staff will oversee the parking lot.

<u>Capacity</u>: The parking lot will have 39 stalls. Per IBC calculations the adjacent Family Center capacity is listed as 1,370.

Hours of Operation: The BGC Family Center will be open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm Monday through Friday and 11:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturdays.

<u>Square Footage (Acreage) of the Site</u>: The site for the parking lot and basketball court will be .62 acres.

<u>Trash Removal and Storage, Snow Removal and Maintenance Equipment</u>: An on-site secured dumpster enclosure has been included in the project.
