Regarding Agenda Item #86997, I'd like to add a request:

For vehicles exiting the Beltline from the north side and turning left onto Mineral Point Road, can you please consider realigning the left turn lane dashed striping so that the two lanes of left turning traffic enter into the two NEW through lanes of Eastbound Mineral Point Road? Currently, the issue is that the leftmost of the two left turning lanes directs the driver into the BRT Lane of Mineral Point Road which now forces the vehicle to merge right soon after their turn.
