| <b>Wisconsin Regional Training Partnership (WRTP)   Building Industry Group Skilled Trades Employment Program (BIG STEP)</b> | Adult        | Community Career Connection (C3)   | WRTP   BIG STEP's Community Career Connection (C3) program will provide individualized career guidance to Kennedy Heights, Parks Cedar, Harmony, and Madison Estates residents with the goal of connecting people to skilled trades careers. C3 services include outreach and orientation at residents' community centers to introduce the apprenticeship pathway, hands-on skill-building activities, testing required for entry into apprenticeships, application assistance, resume workshops, interview practice, and job coaching. | <b>82.5</b> | 35,000.00           |
