

Clymer Place Vacation/Discontinuance

Portion to be Vacated/Discontinued:

Being part of a 16.5 foot wide public right-of-way (alley) within Block 17, plat of University Addition to Madison, recorded August 28, 1850, in Volume A of Plats, page 9, as Document Number 109, located in part of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, Town 7 North, Range 9 East, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 5 of said Block 17; thence Westerly, 363.66 feet, more or less, along the south lines of Lot 5, Lot 4, Lot 3, Lot 2 and Lot 1, said Block 17 to the southwest corner of Lot 1, said Block 17; thence Southerly, 16.5 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 10, said Block 17; thence Easterly, 363 feet, more or less, along the north lines of Lot 10, Lot 9, Lot 8, Lot 7, and Lot 6, said Block 17 to the northeast corner of Lot 6, said Block 17; thence Northerly, 16.5 feet to the said southeast corner of said Lot 5, Block 17 and the **point of beginning**.
