NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Madison Common Council adopt the following as the Vehicle Idling Policy:

No driver of a city vehicle shall cause or allow the vehicle to idle for a period of more than five (5three (3)) consecutive minutes.

in a 60-minute pofiod. The policy shall not apply to:

- 1. Emergency service vehicles, such as fire apparatus, public safety vehicles, or ambulances;
- 2. Vehicles standing in traffic;
- 3. Airport support equipment; OK
- 34. Vehicles being serviced or repaired; (V)
- 45. Idling when necessary to operate auxiliary equipment that is required to accomplish the intended OL

use of the vehicle;

 $\underline{56}$ Idling to provide heat within the cab of the vehicle if the outside temperature is less than $\underline{3240}$ -degrees $\underline{0}$

Fahrenheit, and there is no accessible temperature-controlled area within a reasonable distance and the driver or passengers are in the ;vehicle; or

 $\underline{67}$. Idling to provide cooling within the cab of the vehicle if the outside temperature is more than 80

degrees Fahrenheit, there is no accessible temperature-controlled area within a reasonable distance, the driver or passengers are in the vehicle and the vehicle is equipped with air conditioning
