Bike Madison IdeaScale Comments: What Makes Madison a Great Place to Bicycle? Informational Report on comments submitted from May 2014 through July 17, 2014.

Ross stated that the initial objective of the survey was to receive public input in two phases. The first phase in May and June was to hear comments on what people like about biking in Madison, and the second phase in July and August was for comments on what improvements could be made. The majority of the comments submitted, however, related to infrastructure needs for improvement. The survey will remain open through August for comments.

Webber requested that the comments be shared with consultants working on the Transportation Master Plan. Rummel suggested that the City post an update to Facebook and Twitter to remind people to submit comments before the survey closes in August. Kolar requested that staff compile the data into a summary report. Ross will compile the data and prepare a summary report.
