


Current prevention tactics

- Responsible Beverage service training program for employees
- Advanced training for student supervisors and managers
 - Managers have city issued alcohol operators license
 - Required to attend UWPD safety and alcohol impairment assessment courses
- Mandatory age verification checks at point of purchase
- Age verification checks are routinely performed in public areas by patrolling carding teams
- Partnership with Dean of Students office and UWPD on enforcement and sanctions


















2014 - Scanners deployed 2017- Reduced # due to public awareness campaign

Facts

- Current scanners outdated and no longer can identify fake IDs
- Fake ID production is more sophisticated. Information on magnetic stripes and bar codes are easy to replicate.
- Fake IDs are easily accessible.
- Mixed age environment requires stronger age verification measures
