**Tech Rescue:** High angle and technical recue.

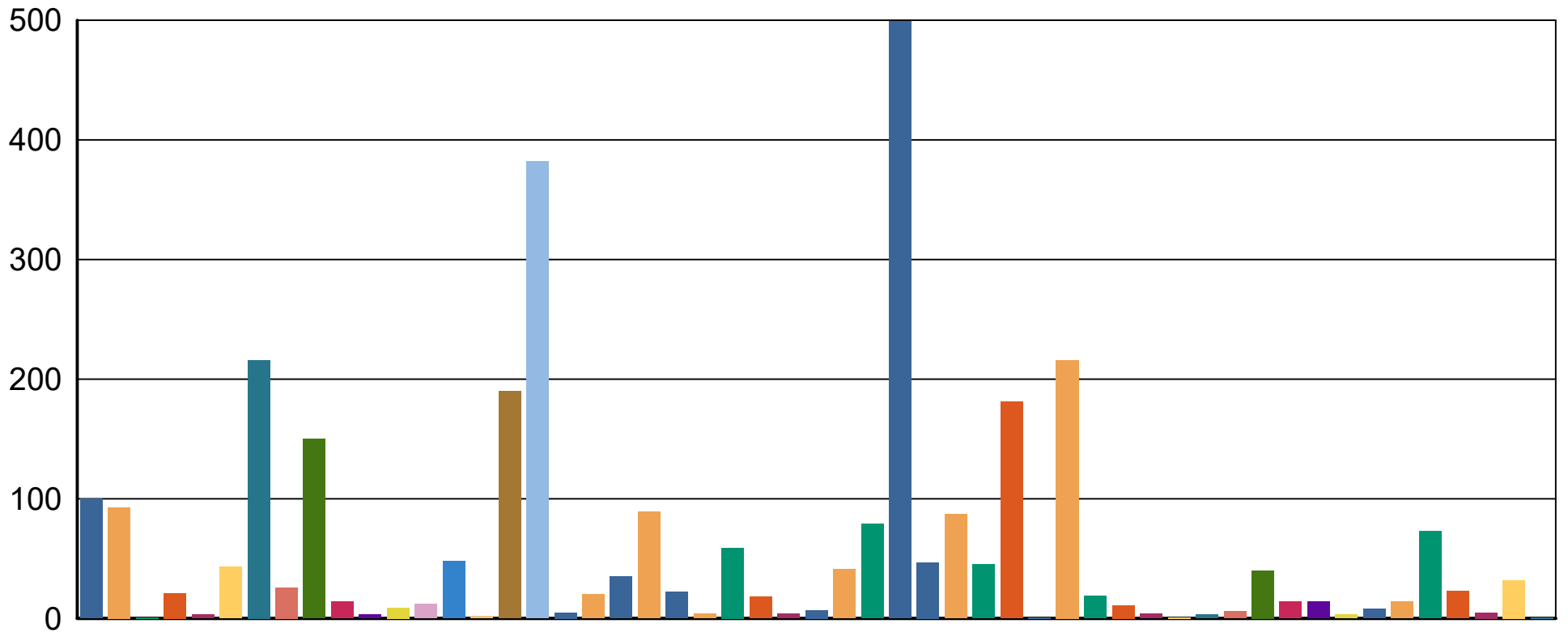

**EMS-Allergies:** Allergic Reaction  
**EMS-Animal:** Injury from an animal.  
**EMS-Assault:** Assault injuries.  
**EMS-BreathProb:** Difficulty breathing and other breathing related problems.  
**EMS-Burn:** Burn related injuries.  
**EMS-Cardiac:** Cardiac arrest ty calls.  
**EMS-Chest Pain:** Call types with chest pains.  
**EMS-Choking:** Choking call types.  
**EMS-CitAsst:** EMS call with a citizen asstance.  
**EMS-CO:** Carbon monoxide call types.  
**EMS-Cold or Heat Exp:** Exposure to cold or heat that requires medical.  
**EMS-Death:** Obvious death.  
**EMS-Diabetic:** Diabetic call types.  
**EMS-Ext:** EMS extrication.  
**EMS-Eye Inj:** Eye injuries that require medical attention.  
**EMS-Faint or Uncons:**  
**EMS-Fall:** Fall realted injuries.  
**EMS-Gun or Stab:** Call types that could be a gun shot, stab wound or impailment.  
**EMS-Head:** Injuries to the head.  
**EMS-Heart PR:** Heart problem call types.  
**EMS-Hemorrhage:** Calls with hemorrhage issues.  
**EMS-Medical:** Medical related calls.  
**EMS-MutalAid:** Mutal Aid calls for other agencies.  
**EMS-OD:** Over does call types. Not limited to narcotics.  
**EMS-Pain:** Pain related call types.  
**EMS-PNB:** Pulseless Not Breathing.  
**EMS Preg:** Pregnancy call types.  
**EMS Psych:** Psychotic call types.  
**EMS Seizure:** Seizure call types.  
**EMS Sick:** Sick call types that range from a sore throat to can't sleep.  
**EMS Stroke:** Stroke call types.  
**EMS-Transfer:** Transfer of patient.  
**EMS-Traumatic:** Call with traumatic injury.

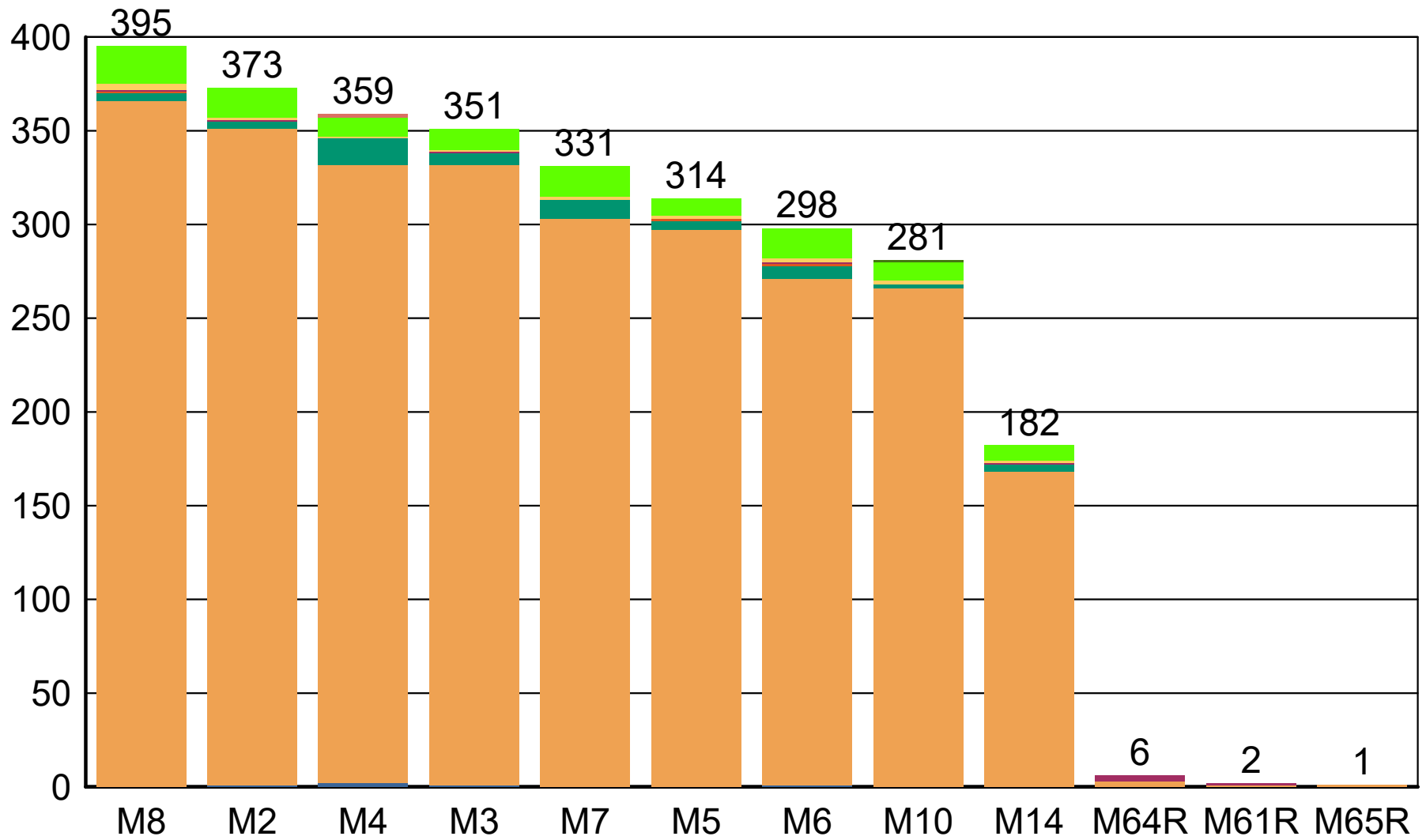
**Fire-Alarm:** Fire alarm call types.  
**Fire-CitAsst:** Citizen assist fire call.  
**Fire-ElecHaz:** Electrical hazord call types.  
**Fire-Explos:** Call types with explosives.  
**Fire-Odor:** The odor of fire is smelled.  
**Fire-Outside:** Outside fire call types.  
**Fire-Smoke:** Call types with smoke present.  
**Fire-Spill:** Call types with hazardous materials need clean up.  
**Fire-StrFire:** Structure fire call types.  
**Fire-SusPkg:** Calls with suspicious packages.  
**Fire-Veh:** Vehicle fire call types.  
**Gask Leak/CO:** Call types with gas leak or CO alarm.  
**HAZMAT:** Calls with hazardous materials.  
**Law-Psych:** Psychotic call types where the primary call is a Law enforcement call.  
**Law-SusPkg:** Law calls with suspicious packages and Fire assigned.  
**MVA:** Motor vehicle accidents.  
**MVA-Ext:** Motor vehicle accidents that require extrication.  
**MVA-TrafAcc:** Traffic accident call typs from no injury to injury.  
**Rescue-Elev:** Elevator recue.  
**Tech Rescue:** High angle or rescues that require speical help.  
**Water Rescue:** Rescure on, in or near water.  
**Water Rescue-EMS:** Rescure on, in or near water w/ patient.

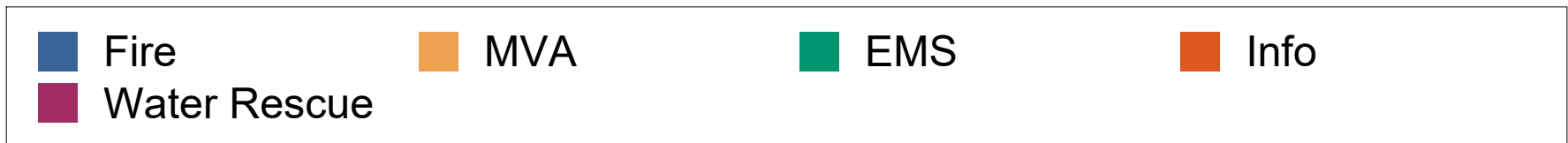

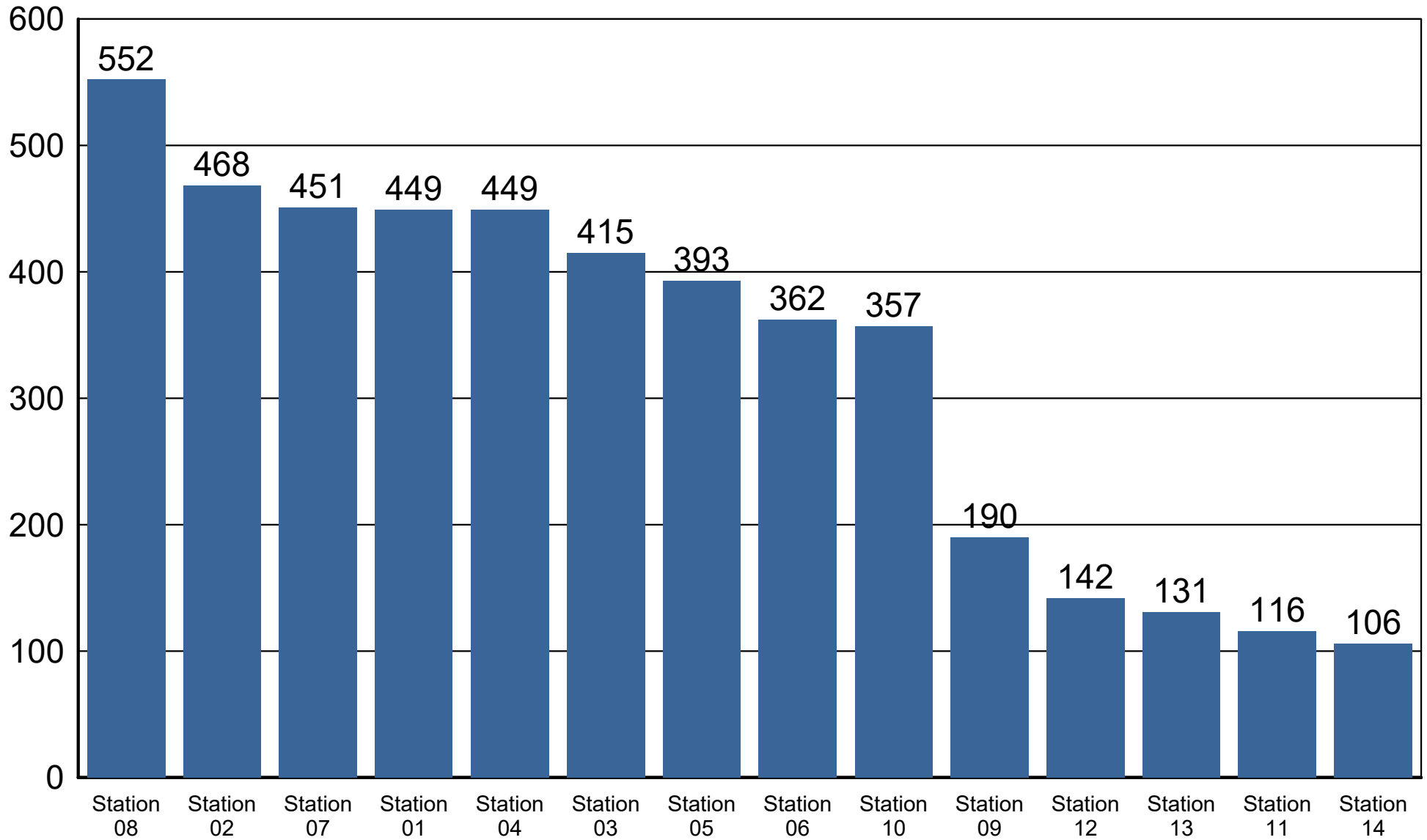




# High Acuity Car 31 Calls
