

# PWD Commission Goals and Logic Model

## Goals

Advocacy for: Enhance the ability of PWD in the City of Madison to access good quality, sufficient quantity, and affordable accessible housing.

## Outcomes

1. Good working relationship with CDA in maintained (initial), barriers are identified (initial) and removed (long-term)
2. Increased “ease to find” accessible affordable housing
3. Sufficient quantity of accessible affordable housing (as compared to baseline)
4. Improved quality of accessible affordable housing (as compared to baseline – note: quality must be defined in measurable terms)

## Outputs

1. Two public forums (community members and providers)
2. Report that includes:
  - a. Issues
  - b. Barriers
  - c. Possible remedies
3. Meeting(s) with Legislative Liaison

## Activities

1. Public forum to identify needs of the community (housing and independent living concerns)
2. Public forum (providers to educate community)
3. Educate and advise Legislative Liaison
4. Collect information (project for intern)
5. Develop mechanism that will establish ongoing oversight of accessible housing issues

## Issues

1. Full report from April 2007 housing conference
2. Town Hall discussion with deaf and hard of hearing
3. Report to CDA
4. Information provided by Center for Independent Living
5. Designated times at full commission meeting for public housing discussion

## Measures

1. Quantity of housing available
2. Number of complaints
3. Satisfaction (disabled community needs met)
4. Quantity of rehabbed property available
5. Quantity of new construction
