14.	00893	Adopting and confirming an Addendum to Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and Mr. Larry D. Nelson, City Engineer.
15.	00896	Submitting the name of George Hank III for confirmation of a five year term as Inspection Unit Director.
16.	00895	Adopting and confirming an Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and George Hank III as Inspection Unit Director.
17.	<u>00871</u>	Re-allocating purchase of service allocations in the 2005 City of Madison budget for services provided through the Girl Neighborhood Power program to the Bridge/Lakepoint neighborhood from the Girl Scouts of Black Hawk Council to the Bridge/Lakepoint/Waunona Neighborhood Center (dba Vera Court Neighborhood Center).
18.	<u>00730</u>	Authorizing a contract between the City and the Madison Metropolitan School District for the provision of programming by Madison School and Community Recreation at Warner Park Community and Recreation Center for 2005. 20.	00868	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign and execute a six (6) month Agreement with three (3) six (6) month renewal periods with Organizacion Latina De Futbol, Inc. to reserve soccer fields at the following City of Madison Parks in exchange for Organizacion Latina De Futbol, Inc.'s maintenance of those fields: Hiestand Park, Warner Park and Elver Park.
