*Individual Contract Amounts with Agencies will be determined by the availability of foreclosed units. The actual amount of NSP provided per unit cannot exceed \$60,000 however some amounts may be lower due to negotiations with the State or with individual agencies regarding eligible costs or project design. Contract amounts with agencies will be based on the ability of the agency to complete the contract in the period required by the contract with the State.

The City and the State may approve some of the above projects in whole or in part as the actual sites are found. Projects would be funded to the extent that the State approves of such funding including modifications approved by the State during implementation in order to meet the States draw rate goals.
