At their meetings of July 8 and July 22, 1985, the Madison Landmarks Commission reviewed in detail the plans for exterior alteration of the Collins House and also reviewed the conceptual use of the house as a bed-and-breakfast inn. The Landmarks Commission voted unanimously at their July 22, 1985 meeting to approve the issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness for the exterior renovations.

They also voted unanimously to recommend that the use of the building as a bed-and-breakfast inn would be compatible with the historic character of the building.
