BASCKGROUND CDA previously awarded 20 Project Based vouchers to Project Home for use in the Prairie Crossing development to further the stabilization of the Allied Drive neighborhood. The original contract was for 30 months beginning August 2007. CDA has twice renewed the contract for 24 months. The current extension expires at the end of the January 2014.
