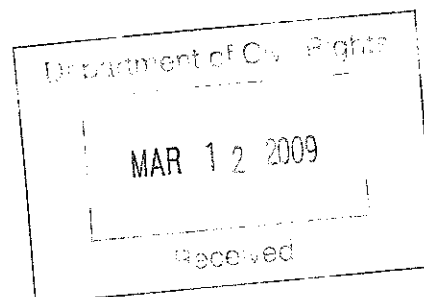

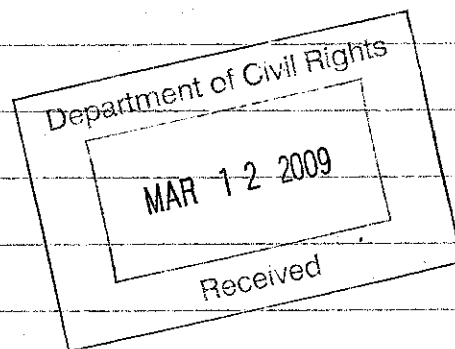
Dear, Madison common council

to be a teen lockdown state.

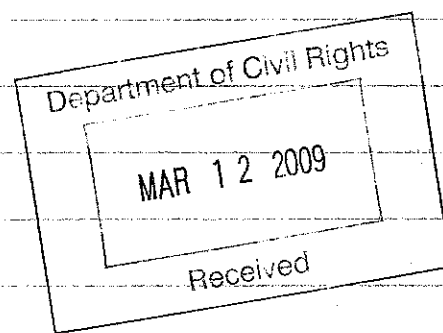
