## **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority of the City of Madison (CDA) has partnered with the Urban Tree Alliance to complete a tree inventory on CDA properties with a focus on Emerald Ash Trees; and

WHEREAS, the tree inventory identified several trees on CDA properties that are tagged as high risk and should be removed and other trees which need ongoing maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Madison College urban forestry program students are in need of sites to complete field work practicums; and

WHEREAS, Madison College has a history of working with community partners to complete these types of applied classes; and

WHEREAS, the CDA has evaluated the potential for CDA properties to be designated as a field work site for the Madison College urban forestry program and has determined this to be feasible; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the CDA Board of Commissioners authorize CDA staff to execute an agreement with Madison College for tree maintenance fieldwork practicums on CDA properties.
