CLG Grant Information Update

1. Daina Penkiunas, National Register Coordinator from the Wisconsin Historical Society was contacted about the study parameters of the potential Post WWI residential neighborhoods. She forwarded two maps, one illustrates the extent of the surveys that they have to date, and the other shows the eligibility of those surveyed buildings. Both these maps, along with the maps presented at the last meeting are attached. Daina mentioned the following points during our conversations:
 - a. Select neighborhoods that include buildings that are potentially eligible for the National Register as individual buildings or collectively as a district. Some historic research might be needed to identify a neighborhood that has significance in the development of Madison.
 - b. Look at geographical neighborhood groupings. The grant application could explain that the survey has been broken into phases and that the following year the City would be applying for a phase 2 survey which looks at the remaining geographical groupings.
 - West side group could include: Sunset Village, Radio Park, Westmorland and the far west edge of Regent and VanChaMasShe.
 - East side group could include: Lake Edge and Eastmorland.
 - North side group could include: Eken Park, Sherman and the Sheridan Triangle
 - South side could include: Bay Creek
 - c. Due to rapidly approaching deadline, send out preliminary letters to consultants explaining the survey plans and ask consultants to respond with letters of interest. Consultants should understand that the survey boundaries have not yet been decided, but the Landmarks Commission is trying to understand budgets and survey scope.
2. Staff has contacted UW Associate Professor Anna Andrzejewski. Ms. Andrzejewski's students have looked at studies in the following neighborhoods (neighborhoods with an * are primarily post WWII):
 - Nakoma Park*
 - Eken Park*
 - Crestwood
 - Nakoma
 - University Heights
 - Midvale Heights*
 - Frost Woods
 - Maple Bluff
3. Staff is looking at neighborhood history brochures (Westmoreland etc), and will report back when more information is gathered.
4. Staff has also attached the CLG Historic Preservation Fund Subgrant Application Guidelines for your review.
