A. Scope of Project

Work will demolish a single-family home and clear site location at 6212 Countryside Lane within the City of Madison limits.

B. Project Recycling Goals

The demolition project, to be in compliance with the City Ordinance, will recycle or cause to be reused at least 70% of all demolition debris, as measured by weight, that is created during this project.

C. Description of Material Anticipated to be generated

- Clean Wood
- Drywall
- Windows
- HVAC equipment, wiring, ductwork
- Appliances
- Miscellaneous Recycling
- Siding
- Electrical Wiring
- Metal Gutters
- Shingles
- (1) Thermostat

D. Worker Education

Supervisors on site will ensure signage for recycling receptacles is accurate, and that the workers are trained to place correct material into the correct location. Recycling goals will also be shared with the workers, with a copy of the plans available on site for reference.

E. Reuse

Bill Fuhrmann performed a walkthrough of the residence and reclaimed following items for reuse.

F. Material Disposition/ Material Handling

METAL

All Metal items will be separated into a metal recycling container. Duct work, wiring, gutters, piping and other metal items will be placed into this container. This will be hauled to L&M Salvage of Richland County Inc.

HAZERDOUS MATERIALS

No asbestos material was identified in the home. (1) Thermostat will be removed and taken to Dane County Clean Sweep. **KEVIN (608) 598-9002**

CONCRETE, ASPHALT, AND BRICK

Most of this material will be separated and crushed to be used as a road base. The rest will be hauled to TRICOR TRANSIT for recycling.

CLEAN WOOD

Wood salvaged from joists, subfloor, and other wood will be put into a recycling container and hauled to TRICOR TRANSIT for recycling.

SHINGLES

Asphalt shingles will be hauled to TRICOR TRANSIT to be recycled.

APPLIANCES

All appliances have been reclaimed and sold by homeowner

MIXED LOADS OF DEBRIS

Clean drywall, siding, and other recyclable construction debris shall be placed into a recycling dumpster provided by TRICOR TRANSIT to be hauled to their demolition recycling facility.

G. Compliance

The demolition contractor shall monitor and track all loads of materials. Upon completion of project the compliance report shall be completed weight tickets/invoices to be included in report.
