

A RESOLUTION amending the “Regulations Governing Vending on State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse” to require Food vendors who operate enclosed food carts to install a LP-gas alarm inside each cart in accordance with the alarm manufacturer’s installation requirements.

WHEREAS, Under Sec. 9.13(6) of the Madison General Ordinances, the Vending Oversight Committee (VOC) is empowered to promulgate regulations not inconsistent with Sec. 9.13, governing the sale of goods and personally prepared food on the State Street Mall and Capitol Concourse; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 9.13 the Common Council must approve the regulations promulgated by the VOC; and

WHEREAS, the regulations are published in documents entitled “Regulations Governing Vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse;” and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on August 26, 2015 the VOC promulgated an amendment to these Regulations as set forth below, using underlines to show new text;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council approve the following amendment to the “Regulations Governing Vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse” recommended by the Vending Oversight Committee:

1. Create Section VI. E. to require food vendors who operate enclosed food carts to install a LP-gas alarm:

VI. REGULATION OF VENDING SITE CLEANLINESS AND SAFETY

E. Food vendors using enclosed food carts shall install and maintain in working order a LP-gas alarm inside each cart in accordance with the alarm manufacturer’s installation requirements.
