8.	<u>01531</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and Chief of Police to accept three highway safety grants totaling \$10,000 from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to conduct pedestrian and bicycle enforcement and produce two pedestrian educational videos.
9.	<u>01534</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a service agreement with the City of Verona for the provision of commuter bus service between West Transfer Point in Madison and bus stops in Verona, including the new Epic Systems campus, starting in September, 2005 for a period of two years, with option for renewal thereafter.
10.	<u>01541</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign and execute an agreement between the City of Madison and WP Beverages, LLC for the provision of vending machine services for cold beverages at Metro Transit's North, South, East, and West Transfer Points for an initial period of one year, with an option to extend the agreement for two (2) periods of one (1) year each by mutual agreement of the parties.
11.	01542	Authorizing a loan from the general fund to the water utility fund and the reimbursement of certain capital expenditures from the proceeds of future waterworks system revenue bonds.
12.	<u>01543</u>	Approving the extension of a loan to Common Wealth Development, Inc., and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an amendment to the loan agreement
13.	<u>01552</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a development agreement to fund a \$4, 274,000 Tax Incremental Finance Loan to the Alexander Co., Inc. and its assigns to assist in the development of the first phase of a mixed-use redevelopment project (Capitol West) located in Block 51 of the West Washington Avenue corridor in the amended TID #28 (Bassett).
