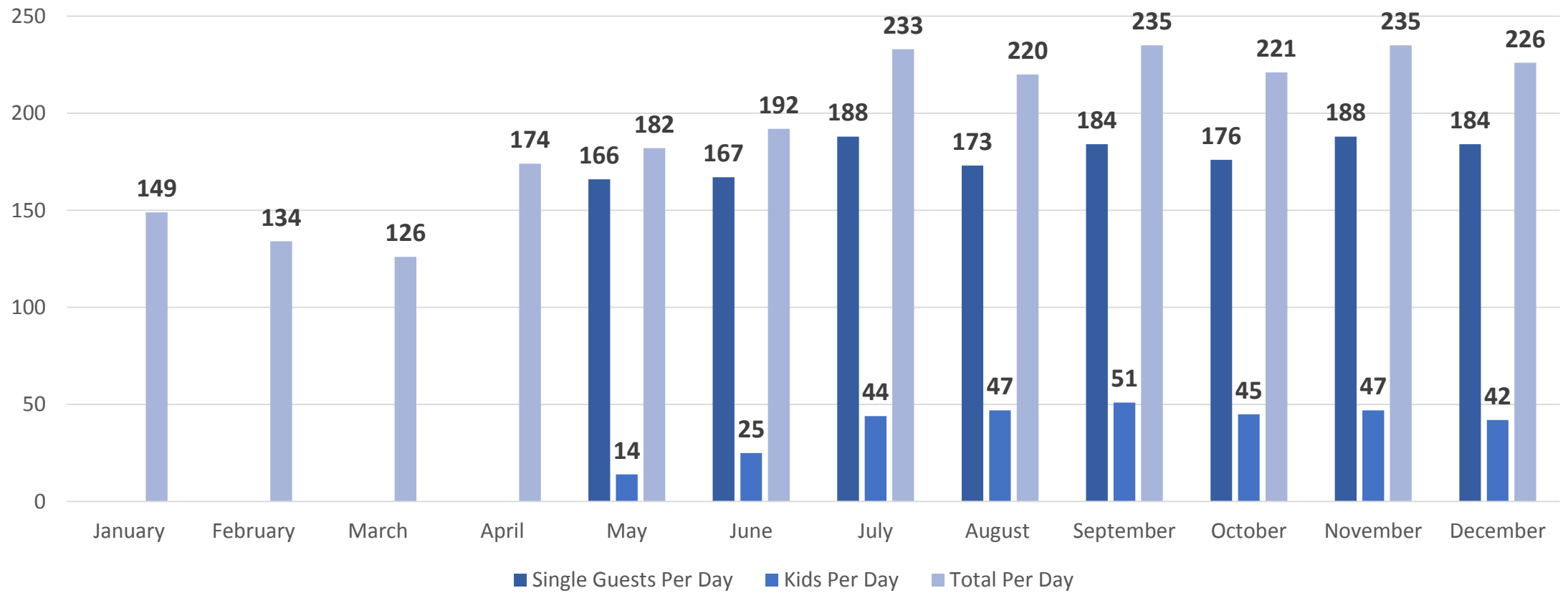

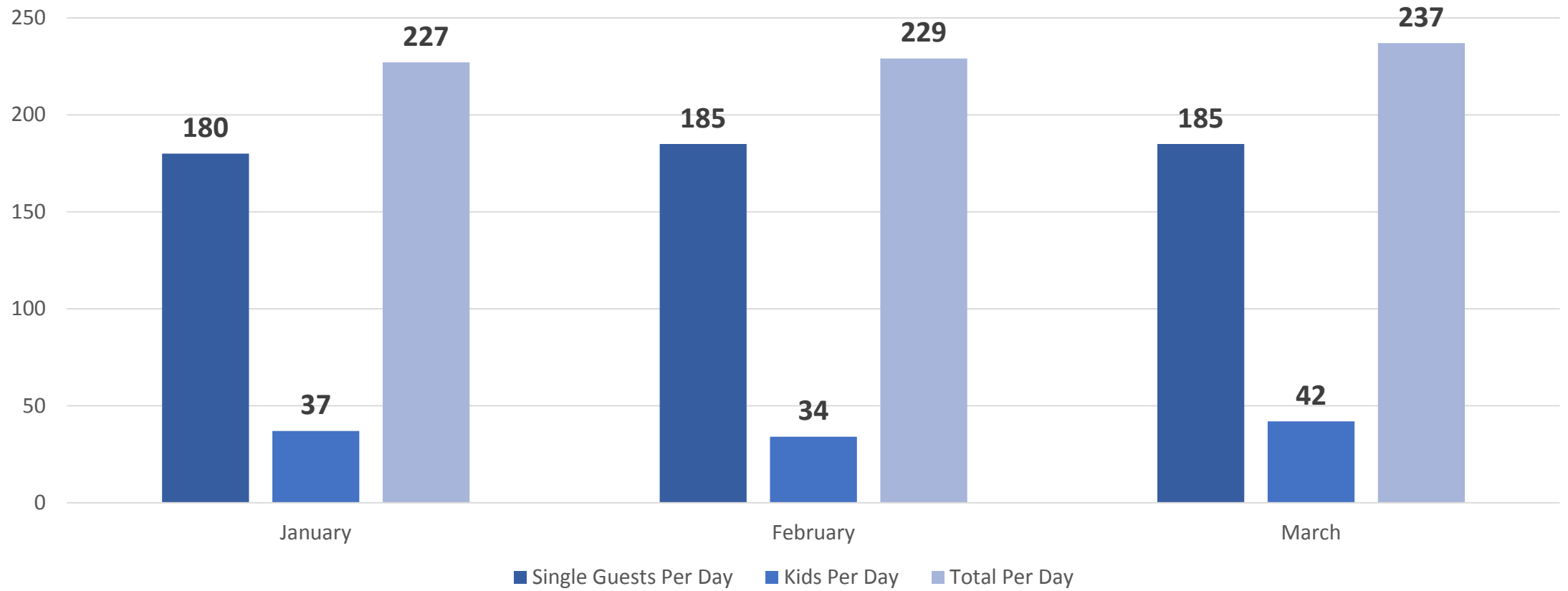

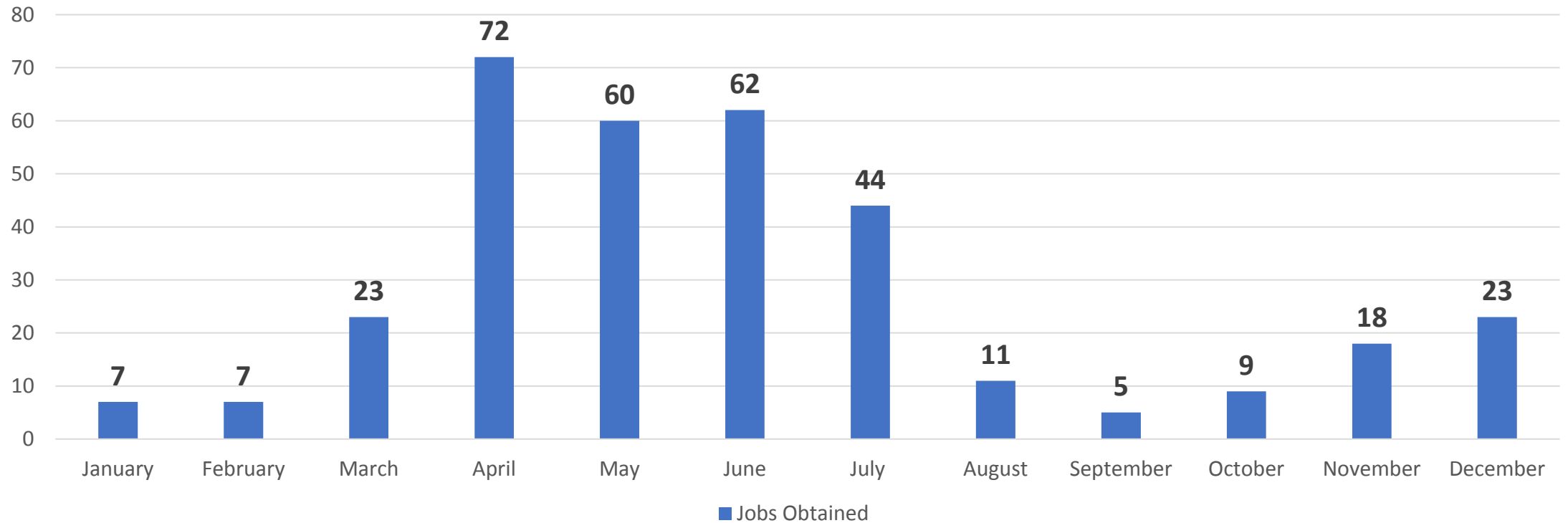

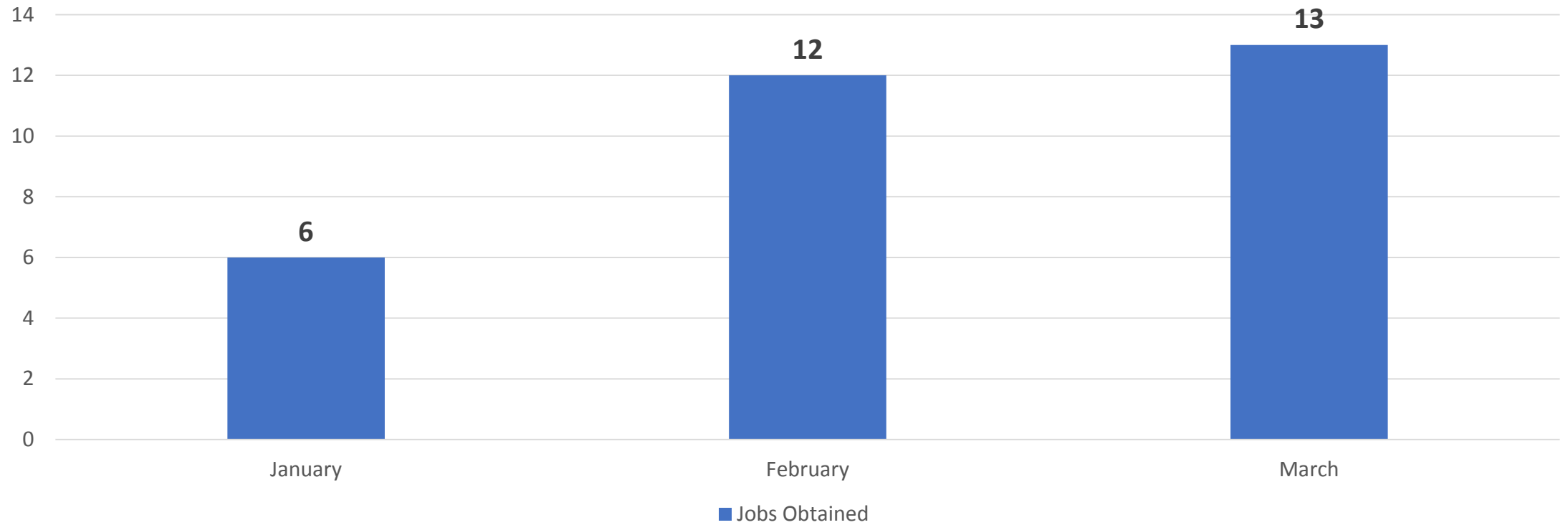


Number of Guests Who Found Jobs

Number of Guests Who Found Jobs

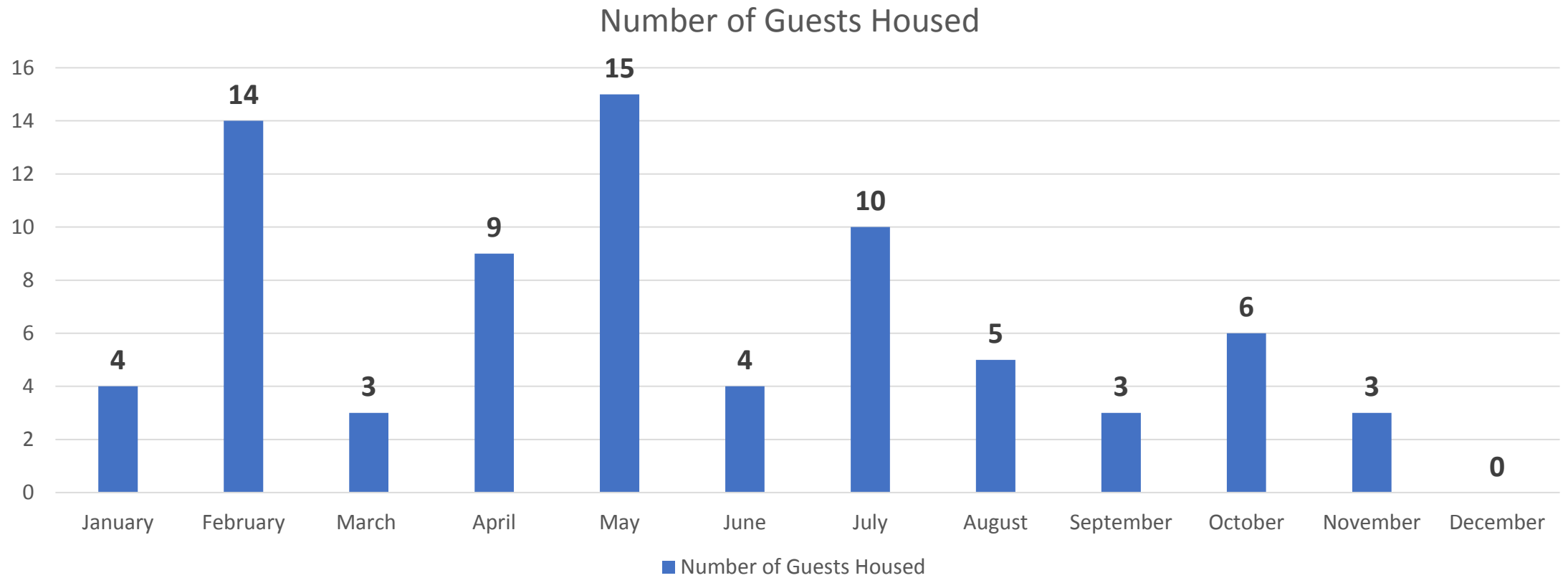


Jobs Obtained Per Month By Guests in 2019

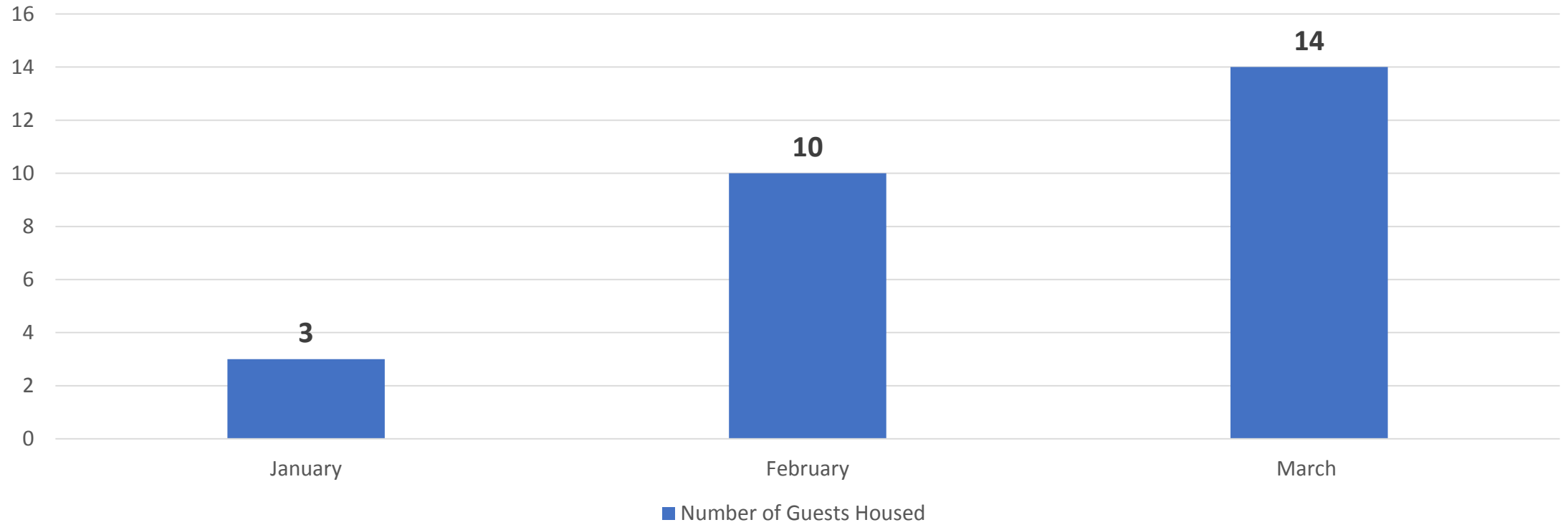

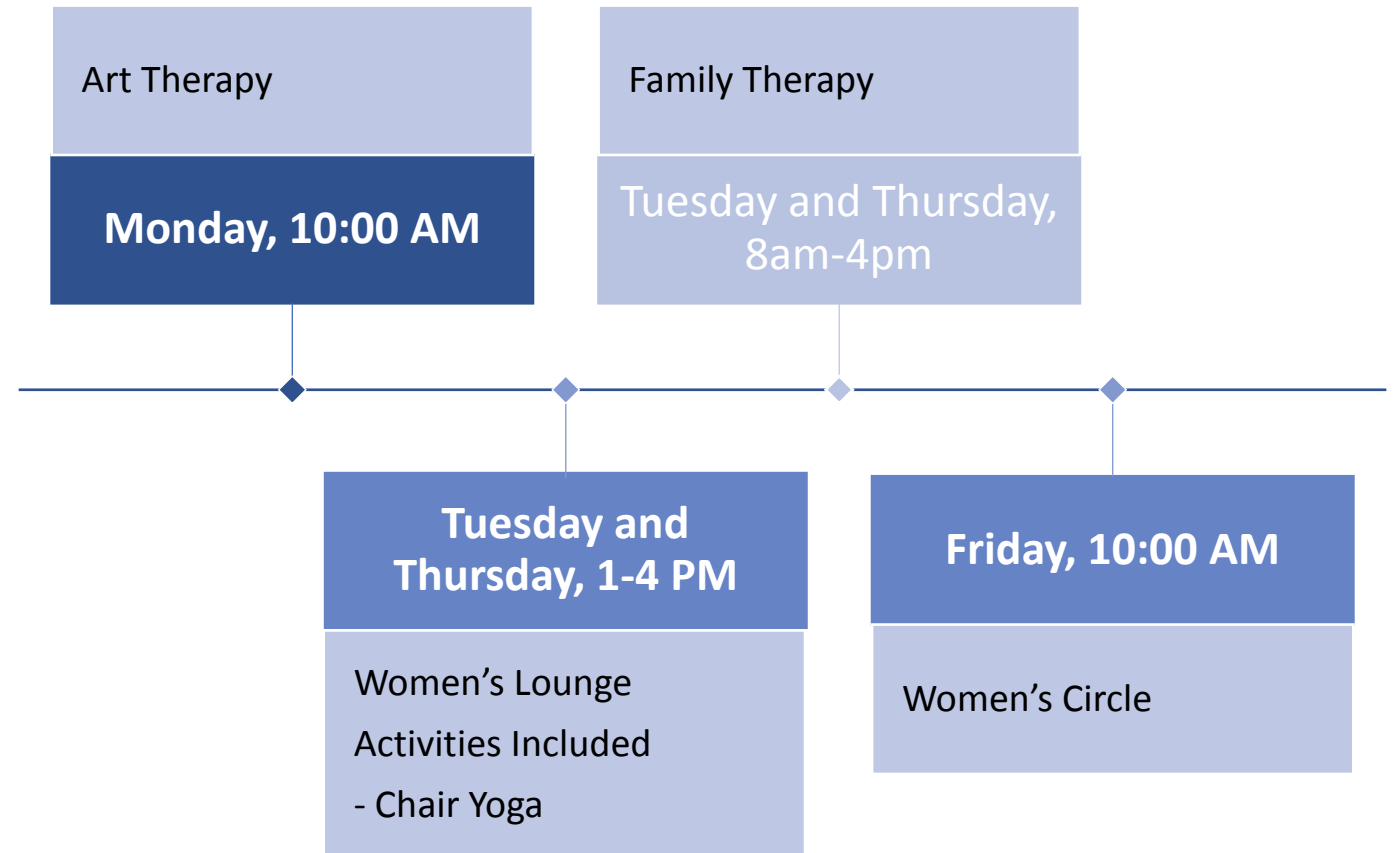
Housing Obtained Per Month By Guests in 2018
