




The developer, TriNova Ventures LLC, has received the City of Madison's conditional approval for a one-lot Certified Survey Map, demolition permit for buildings at 2926 Atwood Avenue & 232 S Fair Oaks Avenue and construct a four (4)-story mixed-use building with 3,900 square feet of retail and 33 dwelling units. The site has frontage on Atwood Avenue and S Fair Oaks Avenue. The project will include eighteen (18)- covered parking stalls on the ground floor at the rear of the building.

Summary of Improvement

- Record a one (1)-lot Certified Survey Map.
- Dedicate Right of Way or grant a Public Sidewalk Easement for and be responsible for the construction of a minimum six (6)-foot wide sidewalk, eight (8)-foot wide terrace, and additional one (1)-foot for maintenance, along their site's frontage of Atwood Avenue and S Fair Oaks Avenue.
- Private Storm Sewer Easement shall be granted by a separately recorded instrument to be recorded immediately after the CSM has been recorded. Development on this parcel is required to accept and convey private drainage onto the site from the adjacent parcels and convey it to the Public ROW.
- Reconstruct public sidewalk, street terrace, curb and gutter, and pavement on S Fair Oaks Avenue and Atwood Avenue per plan approved by the City Engineer.
- Provide public street terrace tree protection, removals, and plantings per City Forestry approvals. City Forestry approved removal:
 - S Fair Oaks Avenue:
 - 21" Green Ash
- Close abandoned driveways with curb and gutter. Construct new private drive entrance aprons per plans approved by the City Engineer and per the Commercial Driveway Permit approved by the City Traffic Engineer.
- Construct private sanitary, storm, and water service laterals necessary to serve the private redevelopment project per plans approved by the City Engineer.
- Provide accessible concrete bus stop during construction. Coordinate location and size with City of Madison Metro Transit.
- Protect existing public streetlights, electrical, and fiber facilities in the project area. Coordinate with City Traffic Engineering and City Information Technology on relocations needed to facilitate construction.
- Coordinate project access, street closures, and street occupancy with other projects in the area and as approved by City Traffic Engineering.





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
