The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subsection (2) entitled "Public Nuisance Authority" of Section 3.15 entitled "City Attorney" of the Madison General Ordinances is created to read as follows:

"(2) Public Nuisance Authority.

The City Attorney is authorized to commence public nuisance actions on behalf of the City under Wis. Stats. Chapter 823, if the following occurs:

- The City Attorney provides written notice to the Mayor and Common Council of the intent
 to file a nuisance action. This written notice shall provide a description of the nuisance
 and why action is necessary.
- 2. The Mayor and Common Council have fifteen (15) days to provide written notification to the City Attorney of an objection to the commencement of a nuisance action and a request for the City Attorney to draft a resolution authorizing the action.
- 3. If there is an objection to the City Attorney's request, the City Attorney must draft a resolution requesting authorization to commence the nuisance action to be heard at the next scheduled Common Council Meeting.
- 4. If the City Attorney does not receive an objection within fifteen (15) days of the provided notice, the City Attorney is authorized to commence a nuisance action as authorized under Wis. Stats. Chapter 823."
