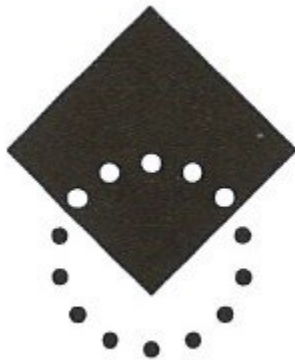
New Programming that has recently started
