The motion for Final Approval passed with the following findings and conditions:

The Commission finds that the Initial Approval conditions have been met, but that the

following design-related conditions shall be addressed which can be administratively approved by staff:

- On the north and east elevations, the colored window patterning shall be continued above and below windows rather than only below, as shown in the previous submittal.
- The casement windows by the front entrance shall be reconfigured to reflect more of a storefront system.
- The art installation shall be inset into a wall versus applied to the surface of a wall.
- The wall behind art shall be metal panel, which shall be detailed consistent with the ACM and masonry detail included in the applicant presentation.
- The art installation location shall be maintained.
- Final review and approval of the art installation can be completed administratively by staff.
- The Commission also notes that if the art installation is a Percent for Art project, the review and approval shall follow the required review process for such projects.

The motion was passed on a vote of (6-1-1) with Asad, Bernau, Harper, Klehr, Knudson, and Rummel voting yes; von Below voting no; and Goodhart non-voting.
