DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This amendment raises the annual fee for having a food and drink permit. It increases the food and drink establishment re-inspection fee. It increases the permit fee to operate a temporary restaurant. It raises the licensing fee for tattoo, body-piercing and ear piercing establishments. It raises the license fee for indoor and outdoor swimming pools. This amendment also raises the fee for food and drink establishment pre-inspection. It raises the license fee for recreation and educational camps.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. Subdivision (g) of Subsection (8) entitled "Food and Drink Permit" of Section 7.07 entitled "Regulations Regarding Food Handled by Public Places" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "(g) The annual fee for the food and drink permit shall be based upon the anticipated gross annual food and drink sales for the licensing year as set forth in the tables below. The licensing year shall be from July 1 through the following June 30. The permit fee herein established shall be for one year or a fractional part thereof. Renewal licenses shall be obtained on or before June 30 of each year or be subject to a late filing fee of 15% of the license fee-or a minimum of \$3.00, whichever is greater. Payment of the late filing fee shall not relieve any person from any other penalties prescribed in this chapter for failure to possess or obtain a license. For the licensing years commencing July 1, 2003 2007, and subsequent thereto:

- 2. Subsection (9) entitled "Reinspection Fee" of Section 7.07 entitled "Regulations Regarding Food Handled by Public Places" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "(9) Reinspection Fee. If the Health Department reinspects a retail food establishment or restaurant because the Health Department finds a violation of this Chapter, the Health Department shall charge the retail food establishment or restaurant owner or operator a reinspection fee of one hundred and ten fifty dollars (\$110150) per reinspection. A reinspection fee is payable when the reinspection is completed, and is due upon written demand from the Health Department."
- 3. Subdivision (b) of Subsection (7) entitled "Temporary Restaurant" of Section 7.08 entitled "Regulations Governing Eating And Drinking Establishments" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "(b) <u>Fee.</u> Pursuant to Sec. 254.69, Wis. Stats., the fee for a permit to operate a temporary restaurant shall be <u>fifty sixty</u> dollars (\$50 60) for the first day and twenty-five dollars (\$20 25) per day for each additional day applied for during one licensing year which year shall be from January 1 through the following December 31 and the permit shall not be transferable."
- 4. Subdivision (d) entitled "Fees" of Subsection (6) entitled "Licensing and Fees" of Section 7.15 entitled "Regulation of Tattooing and Body-Piercing" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "1. Annual establishment fees shall be:
 - Tattoo or body-piercing establishments, \$235 260.
 - b. Ear-piercing establishments, \$155 170.
 - c. Combined tattoo and body-piercing establishments, \$310 340.
 - d. Pre-inspection, one-time only, \$200."
- 5. Subdivision (c) of Subsection (1) entitled "Public Swimming Pool Licenses" of Section 7.44 entitled "Minimum Standards for Public Swimming Pools" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "(c) No license shall be issued unless the operator shall have first submitted an application for a license and a license fee. Renewal licenses shall be obtained on or before June 30 of each year or be subject to a late filing fee of 15% of the license fee. Payment of the late filing fee shall not relieve any person from any other penalties prescribed in this chapter for failure to possess or obtain a license.

- 5. Subsection (4) entitled "Inspection Fees" of Section 7.50 entitled "Pre-Inspection Permits And Fees And Changes Of Ownership " of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "(4) <u>Inspection Fees.</u> Pursuant to authority set forth in Sec. 254.69, Wis. Stats., the fee for a preinspection shall be two three hundred ninety-five fifty dollars (\$295 350) for each inspection. A separate pre-inspection fee shall be paid for each category of permit or license."

- 6. Subsection (4) entitled "Fees" of Section 7.52 entitled "Recreational and Educational Camps" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
- "(4) <u>Fees</u>. The following license fee is hereby established for the period of July 1 through the following June 30 or for any portion of said time period.
