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Tavern Premise - Two story brick building, bar on 1st floor, building about 50' x 80', bar space approximately 600 square feet.

License granted by Common Council with the following conditions:

- 1) Establishment shall not open for business before 7:30 a.m. any day.
- 2) Establishment may remain open until bar time.
- 3) Staff shall make the establishment's regular hot food menu available until 11:00 p.m. each day of operation.
- 4) Establishment shall provide at least one uniformed professional security person satisfactory to the Madison Police Department and such security person shall be on duty from dusk to one-half hour past the closing hour on each day of the establishment's operation; the licensee and security personnel shall be responsible for the activity of staff and patrons inside the establishment and outside the establishment in all areas within the licensee's control.
- 5) The licensee and a representative of the Madison Police Department shall meet at least monthly at mutually agreeable times to review the conduct of the establishment, to assure compliance with these operating conditions, and to work to prevent the recurrence of the circumstances in the amended complaint and any similar occurrences or violations of the law; the department representative shall report on such meetings at the regular meeting of the ALRC or as requested by the ALRC.
- 6) Failure of compliance with these conditions or recurrence of circumstances alike or similar to those described in the amended complaint shall be grounds for revocation of the license.
