Members present were: Stu Levitan, Chair; Erica Fox Gehrig, Vice Chair; Christina Slattery, Jason Fowler, David McLean, Marsha Rummel, and Michael Rosenblum. Fowler left during the discussion of Item 3.

### **SUMMARY:**

Ben Lindberg, representing John Pawasarat, registering in support, wishing to speak, and available to answer questions. Lindberg provided a handout for consideration. Staff explained that this matter was referred at the last meeting so that more information could be provided and so that staff could review the existing windows on site. Staff reported that the windows were reviewed on site and that three are replacement windows from the 1940s.

Lindberg explained that the proposed replacement (Fibrex) windows have a simple profile and an appearance that is appropriate. He confirmed that the horizontal line of the meeting rail will run horizontally from trim to trim.
