### **SUMMARY:**

Staff gave a brief summary of the proposal.

Levitan asked about the Carroll Street elevation and whether the Applicant knows what used to be where there is only a wall shadow now. The Applicant is aware of the shadow, but doesn't know what was there.

Rummel asked if the post sign with directional markers would be moveable. Per the Applicant, yes – that's the intention of the design.

McLean asked about the materials on the wall sign. It's aluminum, so it will not rust. They will also use non-corrosive (stainless steel) fasteners in the mortar joints.
