BACKGROUND

MGO 33.32 creates and designates the Joint Campus Area Committee. On membership it states:

- a) The following members shall be appointed by the City of Madison: Common Council members representing Districts 4, 5, 8, and 13; one (1) resident representative each from the Greenbush, Vilas, and Regent neighborhoods; one (1) resident representative from Capitol Neighborhoods or the State-Langdon Neighborhood; one (1) member of the Plan Commission; **and one (1) member of a transportation-related City committee.**

The Powers and Duties of the Joint Campus Area Committee include:

- Providing feedback on UW-Madison projects
- Identify, discuss, community impact of UW Madison infrastructure and development projects.
- Summarize city/village, UW-Madison, and neighborhood comments concerning current and planned ped/bike/traffic networks and parking
- Provide comments to appropriate Madison or Shorewood Hills committees on development projects, rezoning requests, and Planned Development alterations that are inside the UW-Madison Campus boundary but not covered under Campus-Institutional zoning

Badri Lankella has served as the transportation-related City committee appointment the past. He is willing to serve in this capacity again, however there may be other TPPB members that would like to/are willing to serve.
