Hmong Healthy Living Project

Resolution #2008-12

The Hmong Healthy Living Project seeks to reduce cardiovascular disease and diabetes risk in the Hmong population. There are three components to the project:

- targeted health screening for Hmong adults age 20 and older, with follow-up programming;
- expanded physical activity opportunities for Hmong youth; and
- formation of a Hmong health council to plan and oversee health promotion programs for the Hmong community.

The Department has received a grant of \$4,000 from the American Heart Association to support this project.

Under the terms of the IGA, the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County may approve new grants that are less than \$50,000, provided that there is no requirement for additional appropriations and the grant does not require additional permanent of project staff (IGA, Section VIII, Paragraph F). This resolution authorizes the receipt of this grant and recognizes the revenue and expenditure of these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County is authorized to accept a grant from the American Heart Association, Midwest Affiliate for \$4,000 to conduct a project to reduce cardiovascular and diabetes risk in the Hmong population and the Director is authorized to sign the contract agreement for the period July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the 2008 Operating Budget for Public Health—Madison and Dane County is amended by the following amounts:
