









HOUSE FRONT ELEVATION

GARAGE FRONT ELEVATION





A. Scope of Project

Work will demolish a single family home and clear site located at 2621 Moland St within the City of Madison.

B. Project Recycling Goals

The demolition project, in order to be in compliance with City Ordinance 10.185, will recycle or cause to be reused at least 70% of all demolition debris, as measured by weight, that is created during this project.

C. Description of Material Anticipated to be Generated

- a. Concrete
- **b.** Clean wood
- **c.** Windows
- **d.** Siding (cement on house)
- **e.** Aluminum trim and gutters
- **f.** Shingles (asphalt)

D. Worker Education

Supervisors on site will ensure signage for recycling receptacles are accurate, and that workers are trained to place correct material into the correct location. Recycling goals will also be shared with the workers with a copy of the plan available onsite for reference.

E. Reuse

Habitat for Humanity Restore East was contacted on April 7, 2021 and declined to reclaim any of the building materials.

The owner will attempt to reclaim any usable clean lumber.

F. Material Disposition/Material Handling

Hellenbrand Brothers Excavating will use Royal Container Service (608-221-1919) dumpsters for all demolition materials. The dumpster contents are sorted and recycled by Royal Container Service.

G. Hazardous Materials

Building will be inspected on April 14, 2021 and tested for universal wastes, lead, and asbestos by Advanced Health and Safety. These materials will be addressed following state and local guidelines.

H. Compliance

The demolition contractor shall monitor and track all loads of material. Upon completion of the project the compliance report, which is available on the Streets Divisions' website, shall be completed. Appropriate weight tickets and/or invoices will be included with the compliance report when it is submitted.
