

Safe Streets Madison

March 23, 2022

Action Requested:

- Approval of additional projects
 - \$1,400,000 total funding to award
 - Approved \$592,620 on Feb 23, 2022
 - Phase 2 Recommended Project List
 - Staff recommending approval of \$389,827 in additional projects.
 - This would bring total approved to \$982,447.
 - An additional \$417,553 would be available for Phase 3 approval.
 - Approval spreadsheet shows \$674,927 in total projects that have been reviewed for solutions, scored and cost estimates provided. Any projects not funded will stay on the list for Phase 3 consideration.

1. Spreadsheet Changes - based on feedback from February

 - b. Removed information on former programs (Vision Zero, Traffic Calming, Ped/Bike, School) as it is no longer applicable
 - c. Added Status
 - i. Approved
 - ii. Recommended – Projects that have been fully scored based on a proposed solution and cost estimate
 - iii. Data/Engagement Needed – Projects being developed for future funding phase
 - iv. Hold – Projects with other funding, projects that need coordinated with other projects/improvements
 - v. Potential Future Project – Lower safety & ped/bike gap score but may move forward for consideration in the future
 - d. Alder District column added; working on completing information for all projects
 - e. Request ID
 - i. New projects have larger ID #
 - ii. No longer renumbering as projects are scored
 - iii. Locations with multiple solution options have “a”, “b” added to number so it will be easier to pick out projects with multiple solutions/scores
 - iv. Request ID will be shown on plan sets to make it easier to review documents
2. Project List
 - a. New project locations were added and will continue to be added
 - b. New projects that scored well for safety/gaps have been recommended for approval or for data/engagement as appropriate

- c. Changed some projects from Data/Engagement to Potential Future Project to reflect project locations most likely to be included in Phase 3 recommendations
 - i. If time/budget allows, more projects will be reviewed for recommendations in Phase 3
- 3. Projects listed as Engagement/Data Projects
 - a. Phase 3 Projects
 - i. Additional projects will be brought forward with recommended solutions in May/June
 - ii. Late summer contract with project completed in 2022 or 2023
 - b. Future Projects
 - i. Continue to review and bring to TC based on funding availability
