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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING before the Transit and Parking Commission Parking Utility Rate Modification Proposal

Wednesday, March 14, 2012 at 6:00 PM
Room 260, Madison Municipal Building
On Wednesday, March 14, 2012, at 6:00
PM in Room 260 of the Madison Municipal
Building, 215 Martin Luther King
Jr. Boulevard, the Parking Utility and
the City of Madison Transit and Parking
Commission will hold a public hearing
on proposed parking rate modifications
tentatively go into effect in June 2012.
The last general rate increase was in
June 2009.

Citizens are encouraged to come and
publicly comment on the staff proposal.
Some key elements of the proposal are:
* Raising the on-street multispace meter
rate from \$1.70/hr. to \$1.75/hr.
* Raising periphery on-street meters by
50¢/hr to \$1.50/hr.
* Raising the on-street single-pole meter
rates from \$1.50/hr to \$1.75/hr.
* Raising the parking lot metered rates
by amounts of 6¢/hr. to 30¢/hr.
* Raising the resident monthly rates by
amounts of \$4/mo. to \$15/mo.
* Raising the non-resident monthly rates
by amounts of \$4/mo. to \$16/mo.
* Annual residential parking permits to
remain at \$21 (no change).
* Meter hoods and hangtags to increase
by \$1.00/day.
* Lost ticket fee to cost \$30.

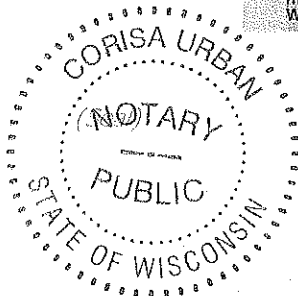
