CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 4:30pm.

1. 81740 PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no registrants wishing to speak and there were no written public comments. There was one registrant available to answer questions on agenda item 8. The registrants report is attached.

Council President Currie noted a recusal on agenda item 11 as an employee of the YWCA.

CONSENT AGENDA

Agenda items 2-8 and 10-12 were moved to be on the Consent Agenda. A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to Adopt the Consent Agenda. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

ITEMS TO BE CONSIDERED

2. Recreate the 1.0 FTE position #4525 of Clerk Typist 2 (CG20, R6) as an Administrative Clerk 1 (CG20, R9) and reallocate the employee to the new position.

A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

3. Recreate the 1.0 FTE position #698 of Real Estate Development Specialist 3 (CG18, R10) as a Real Estate Development Specialist 4 (CG18, R12) and reallocate the employee to the new position.

A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

4. 81359 Recreate position #1726 of Planning GIS Specialist as a GIS Specialist 3 in

CG 18, Range 10 and reallocate the employee, C. Stoughtenger, to the new position. A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other. 5. 81361 Delete the classification of Crossing Guard Supervisor in CG18, R01 from the salary schedule; recreate the classification in CG18, R03; recreate position #2648 and #2659 in the new classification, and reallocate the employees to the new positions. A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other. 6. 81566 Authorizing a non-competitive service contract with Sustain Dane through 2026 to administer the Efficiency Navigator Program to provide energy efficiency upgrades to naturally occurring affordable housing. A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other. 7. 81635 Approving contract amendment #1 with Masabi LLC, to include non-competitively selected Service installations and changes to equipment quantities for the new 60' electric bus fleet. A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other. 8. Authorizing the process to select a public art feature for the Imagination 81621 Center at Reindahl Park and authority to transfer of \$25,000 in Percent for Art Funds from the Metro Transit Satellite Facility to the Imagination Center (District 12 and District 17) A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other. 9. 81625 Authorizing amendments to Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) funded contracts with Urban Triage, Inc. and LGBT Outreach, Inc. on behalf of the Madison/Dane County Continuum of Care (CoC), authorizing an amendment with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to extend the YHDP grant's performance period, and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute new Purchase of Service agreements for services performed between January 1, 2024 and February 28, 2025. A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Rummel, to Return to Lead with the Recommendation for Approval to the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK **GRANT COMMITTEE.** The motion passed by voice vote/other. 10. 81628 SUBSTITUTE Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute contract

amendments, utilizing federal Emergency Rental Assistance funds awarded

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by the U.S. Treasury Department and authorized under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, to the African Center for Community Development; Meadowood Neighborhood Association/Meadowood Health Partnership; Nehemiah Community Development Corporation, with FOSTER of Dane County; and Tenant Resource Center to sustain efforts to prevent evictions and promote housing stability for eligible households in Dane County. (Citywide)

A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to Return to Lead with the Recommendation for Approval to the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COMMITTEE. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

11. <u>81612</u>

Authorizing the City of Madison to accept an Employment Grant (EG) award of \$75,000 from the Wisconsin Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR) to be administered by the City's Community Development Division (CDD); authorizing the Mayor to sign any requisite agreement with the State to formally accept these EG grant funds from DEHCR; authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement with YWCA of Madison, Inc. to carry out the goals of this grant; and amending CDD's 2024 Adopted Operating Budget as appropriate.

A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT (15 VOTES REQUIRED) - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other. Council President Currie recused herself on this item.

12. <u>81622</u>

Accepting \$400,000 from Dane County, authorized in the County's 2024 Adopted Budget to support the Dairy Drive urban campground, amending the Community Development Division's 2024 Operating Budget to reflect receipt of those funds, authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a contract with Dane County, and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a contract with MACH OneHealth to use these funds to support the Dairy Drive campground, to supplement City-administered American Rescue Plan Act funds previously allocated to the campground and other funding secured by MACH OneHealth from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). (District 16)

A motion was made by Currie, seconded by Verveer, to Return to Lead with the Recommendation for Approval to the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COMMITTEE. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
