Report to the Library Board October 2010

Discussion of eastside site for future branch library

Alder Clausius has asked City Real Estate and the Planning Department to explore property at 1760 Eagen Road for a possible future new northeast side branch library. Site information is enclosed, as is the Board's approved Branch citing criteria. Don Marx, Real Estate, and Mike Waidelich, Planning and Development, will be at this meeting to assist with the discussion.

Authorization for retaining legal services for New Market Tax Credits:

This City Council resolution authorizing the City to retain the Law Firm of Quarles & Brady, LLP, for legal services for New Market Tax Credits financing for the proposed new Central Library (in your packet) needs approval by the Library Board.

Awards

Although it hasn't been officially announced yet, we have been informed that MPL has again garnered a star rating in *Library Journal's annual Starred Libraries* ratings. Hennen's *American Public Library Rankings* also has Madison Public Library in the top ten for its population category. MPL also makes a strong showing in its population category in the *Public Library Data Service Statistical Report*, based on population.

Update
