### **SUMMARY:**

There was general discussion about the nomination. Andrzejewski provided the following comments to be conveyed to the Wisconsin Historical Society:

- The low stone retaining walls are contributing features, but are not specifically noted. The introduction mentions buildings scattered throughout, but the stone walls are not mentioned.
- The Arboretum is significant for all criteria (a, b and c). For criterion b, Leopold, Nolen and Lapham are not noted.
