




Make Music Day



- Launched in 1982 in Paris, France by Jack Lang, Minister of Culture of France
- Celebrates the power and joy of live music
- Performances are always free and open to the public
- Nearly 120 countries and 1,500 cities participate









Make Music Madison



- 12th year as part of international Make Music Day, one of the founding cities
- Initiated by the City of Madison and community volunteers to activate neighborhoods through the arts.
- Now a 501(c)(3) with 1 part time staff + student interns
- 621 performances in 2023







Performers



- In 2023 we had over 300 registered performance groups representing an estimated 1500 individual artists
- All ages and experience levels welcome
- Dozens of genres represented, such as:
 Bluegrass, Country, Cultural, Folk, Funk, Hip-Hop,
 Gospel, Jazz, Indie-Rock, Latin, Punk, R&B & More!








Venues
