# 1. STRUCTURE OF JCAC AS A BODY

<b>Question:</b>	<b>Should the organizing structure of this committee change?</b>
<b>Options Discussed:</b>	City committee; UW committee; community-university partnership
<b>Proposed Recommendation:</b>	Remain a City committee
<b>Rationale:</b>	City management is a negotiated condition of the UW's alternate development review path under the Campus-Institutional zoning.

## 2. SCOPE OF TOPICS AND DUTIES

<b>Question:</b>	<b>Are there changes to the duties to better align with the committee's mission?</b>
<b>Options Discussed:</b>	<p>Narrowing/adding specificity related to private development review (next slide)</p> <p>Expanding to issues like campus safety (e.g. Mifflin St Block Party safety plan)</p>

# EXCERPT OF JCAC POWERS AND DUTIES

Per [MGO 33.32\(b\)](#), the Committee shall:

*(b) Identify, discuss, and summarize community-wide and neighborhood impact of UW-Madison infrastructure and development projects, city/village-initiated infrastructure and development projects, and private sector development projects inside the campus boundary and within a quarter mile of the campus boundary. When relevant, make recommendations on whether a project should be approved and/or recommend strategies to mitigate negative impacts to applicable City, Village, or UW-Madison committee(s), commission(s), or other governing bodies.*

For section in yellow, consider limiting to UW impacts because communitywide impacts are considered in other City committees.

### 3. GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES / JURISDICTION

<b>Question:</b>	<b>Should JCAC's scope be for all area within ¼ mile of the campus boundary, or something smaller?</b>
<b>Options Discussed:</b>	<p>Options to shrink it: 1/8 mile; adjacent properties; tailored based on surrounding land use</p> <p>Keep as is until campus master plan update in case campus boundary changes.</p>





## 4. MEMBERSHIP

<b>Question:</b>	<b>Should any changes be made to the membership?</b>
<b>Options Discussed:</b>	<p>Make some alder seats non-voting</p> <p>Reduce seats for inactive community organizations</p> <p>Other changes based on scope decisions</p>
