The SHPO REC recently determined that the structure at 935 W. Johnson Street, Madison, WI, as not eligible for inclusion on either the National Register of Historic Places, nor the WI State Register of Historic Places. As such, it is the opinion of the WI SHPO the proposed demolition may proceed as planned. In the even that demolition plans change, or cultural resources or human remains are encountered during the demolition phase, all work should cease and this office notified so we may continue the consultation process.
