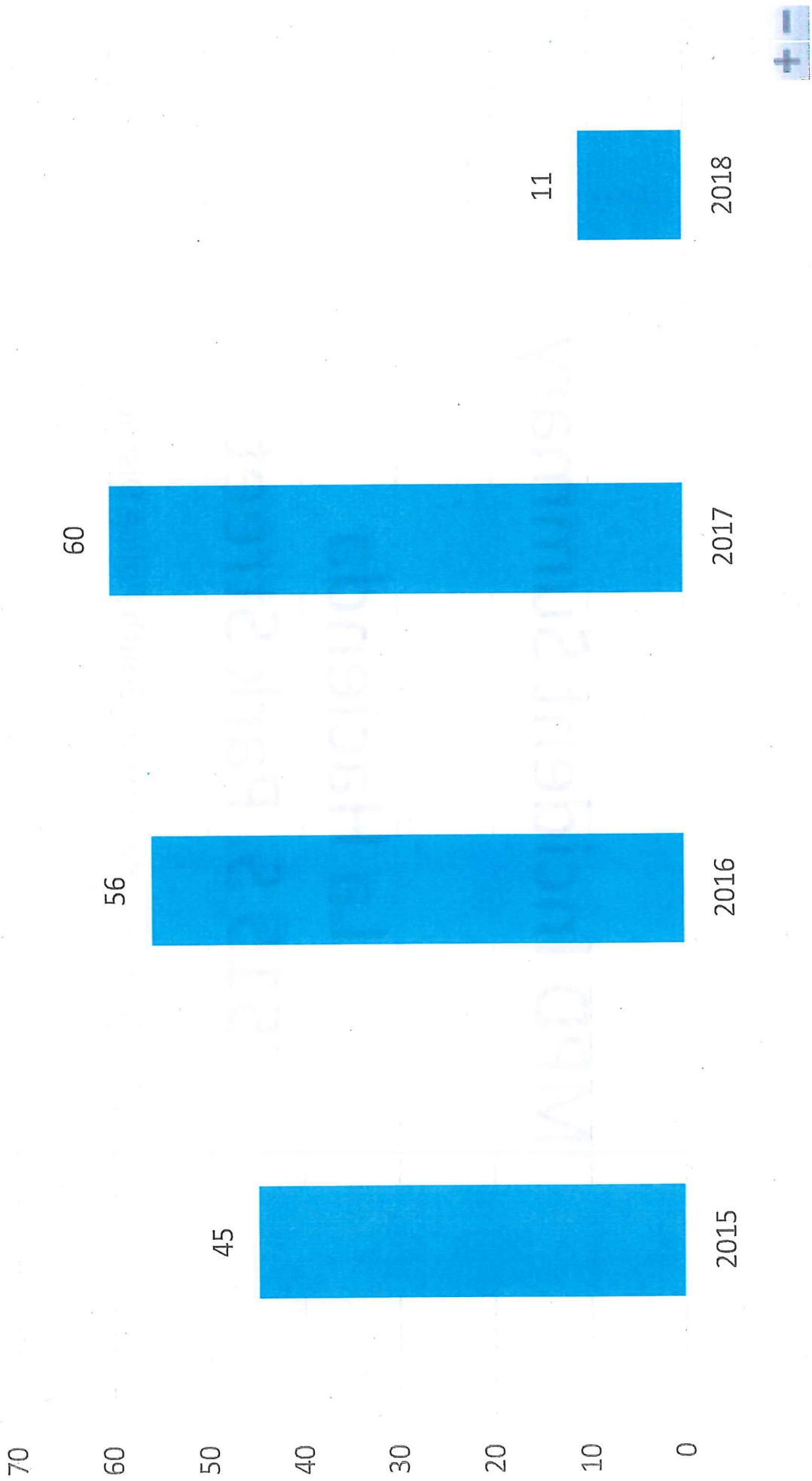

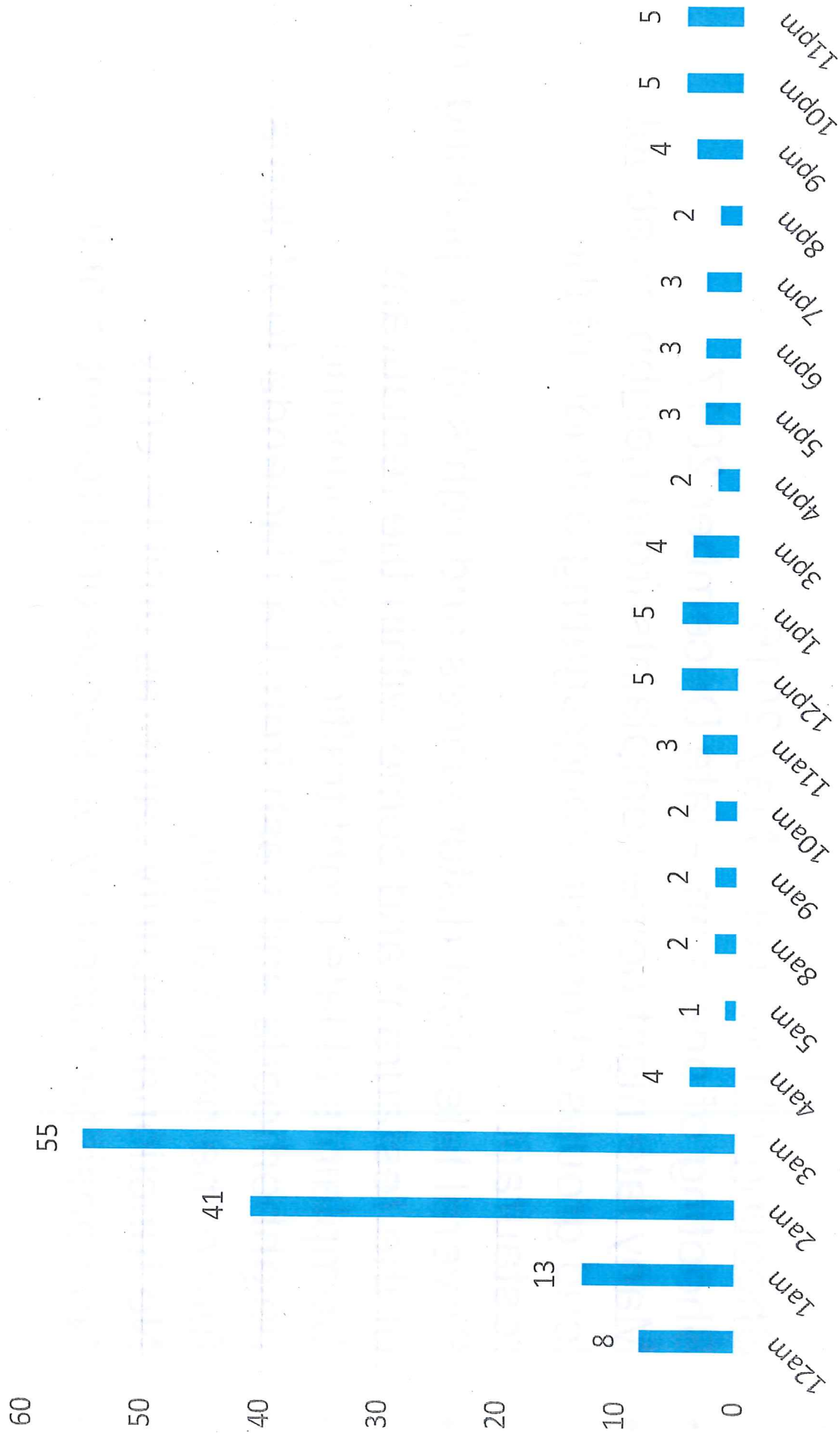
# 2015 - 2018 Incidents by Year



# Notable Incidents and Concerns

- Shooting of two men - May 2016
- Shooting of one man – late December 2017
- Many late night noise complaints from neighbors about loud groups of people congregating outside of the restaurant
- Several late night disturbances and fights in the parking lot of the restaurant and some within the restaurant
- Complaints of late night traffic in surrounding neighborhoods and trash from La Hacienda food items found the next morning
- No functional security cameras until recently
- No consistent security presence until recent months

# Notable Incident Summary

- Command Staff met with owner of La Hacienda in mid-2017 about security and safety at the restaurant
- JBM security was hired and worked the restaurant for a short period of time
- New security company hired in late fall of 2017
- Command Staff met again with owner in early January following the shooting of a man
- Community meeting in March of 2018 with close to 60 attendees.
- ALERT meeting in April with owners who voluntarily agreed to proposed conditions which were effective at the end of May

# New License Conditions

- La Hacienda will close every night of the week at 2am
- La Hacienda will employ security staff to monitor the interior and exterior of the restaurant
- La Hacienda will install security cameras inside and outside (4 inside and 5 outside) and will make footage available to MPD upon request
- La Hacienda will pick up trash in their lot and the nearby neighborhood streets every night after closing
- La Hacienda will meet with MPD and the community in October (sooner if problems continue) to review conditions and hours of operation
