

Charge

The Madison Election Advisory Committee was created in 2006 with the following charge:

- 1) Evaluate current procedures for elections;
- 2) Make recommendations for improvements in registration, polling places, voting equipment, election official training, ballots, absentee ballots and tabulating votes;
- 3) Monitor elections for optimal & appropriate accuracy convenience, fairness & legality;
- 4) Evaluate & make recommendations on State & Federal law changes as it relates to elections;
- 5) Recommend methods to maintain proper balance between the security of elections, openness of the process & the right to a secret ballot;
- 6) Solicit public comments & recommendations;
- 7) Forward an annual report to the Council, Mayor, or City Clerk.
