 80734 Discussion on how the Alcohol License Review Committee can provide support to non-English speaking applicants to make informed decisions

Discussed scheduling an ALRC meeting where the Department of Civil Rights and possibly the city's community connectors could sit in. Committee members could also attend a city training on plain language workshop to learn to communicate better with translators to help applicant. The subcommittee identified entertainment licenses ordinance language and its application process as an area to simplify for applicants. The City Attorney's Office is working on a "matrix" to provide to applicants, to assist them in the licensing application process. Lastly, the recent addition of two bilingual (Spanish) City Clerk staff will improve language access for Spanish-speaking applicants submitting applications to the Clerk's Office.
