**City of Madison Child Care Assistance
 2014 Stabilization Funds Allocation**

\$40,000 of the \$745,846 Child Care Assistance Budget is allocated to Stabilization Funds. Stabilization Funds are typically awarded on a two-year cycle. 2014 is the start of the new two-year cycle. New applications were submitted and reviewed. All applicants qualified and have been awarded the amounts listed below.

Stabilization Funds are intended to stabilize City of Madison accredited non-profit centers serving low-income families and children. For the purpose of the Stabilization application, low-income is defined as families receiving public assistance for the cost of childcare (i.e. City of Madison Child Care Assistance or WI Shares Child care Subsidy), as well as children and families enrolled in the Transitional Education Program (TEP).

Applicants are required to serve minimally 20% of their program as low-income families & children as defined above.
