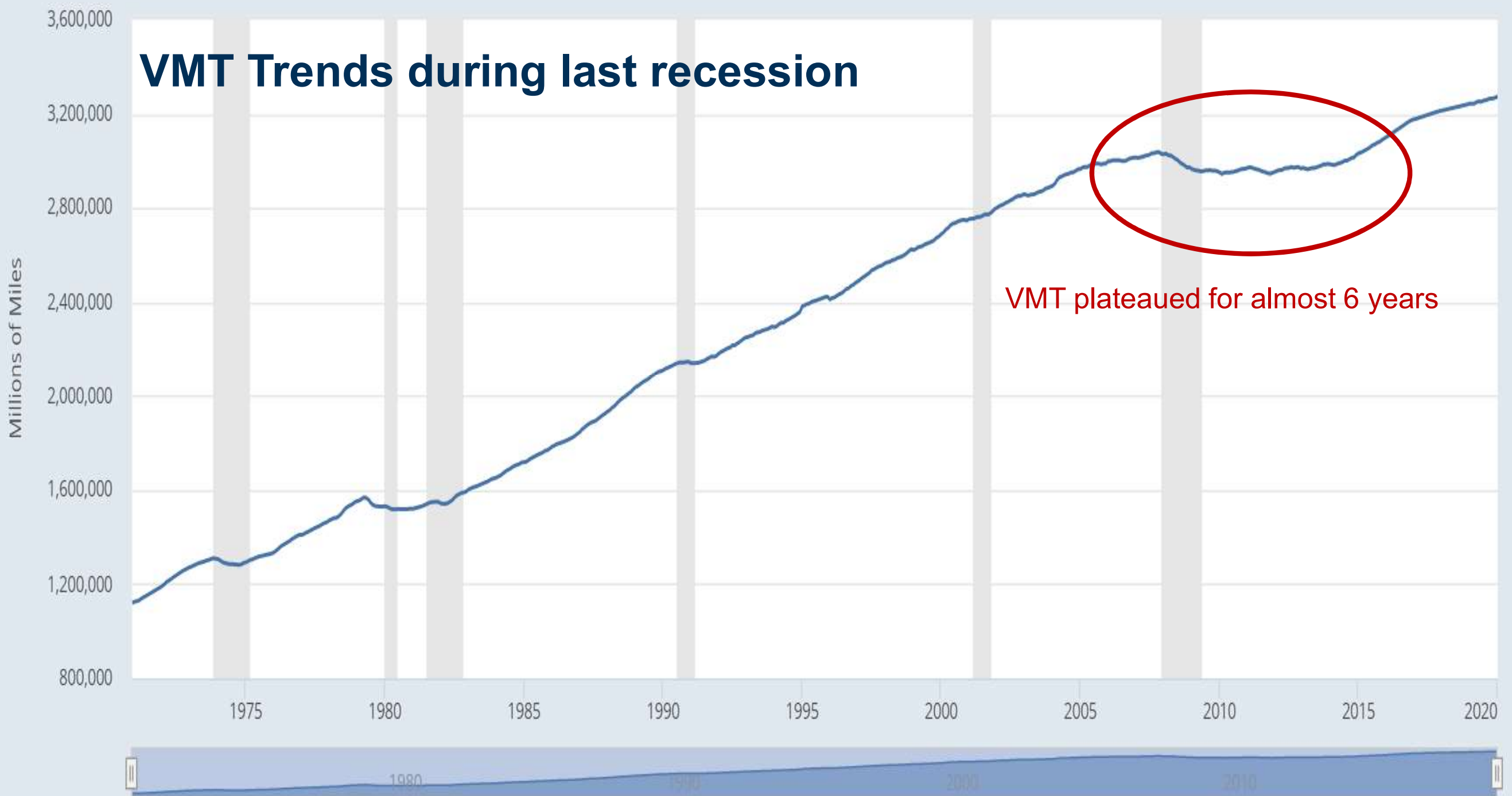

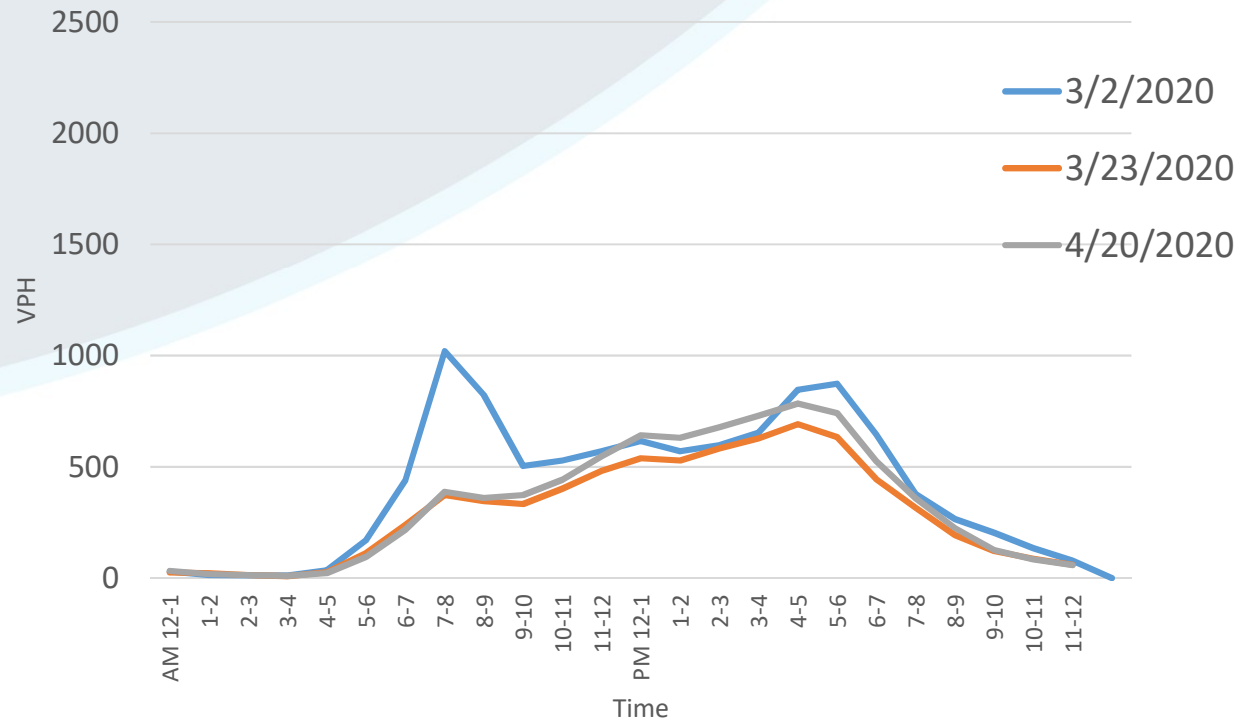
VMT Trends during last recession



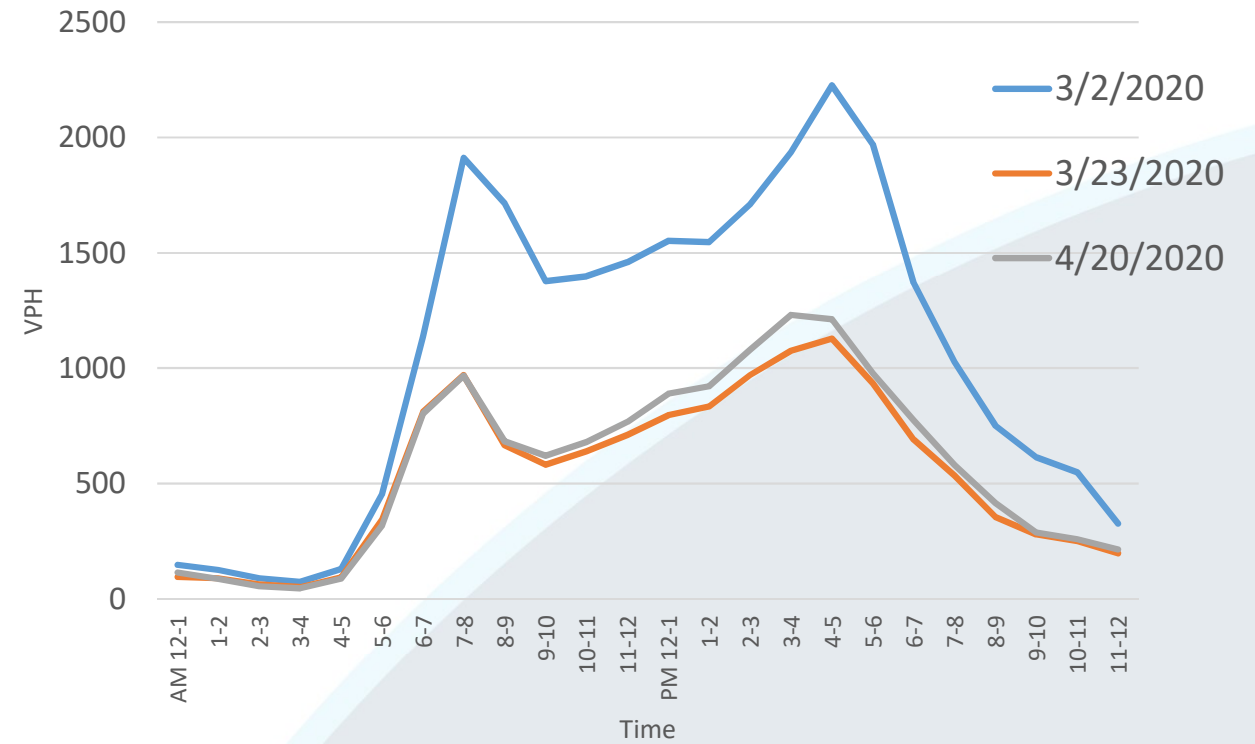
VMT plateaued for almost 6 years

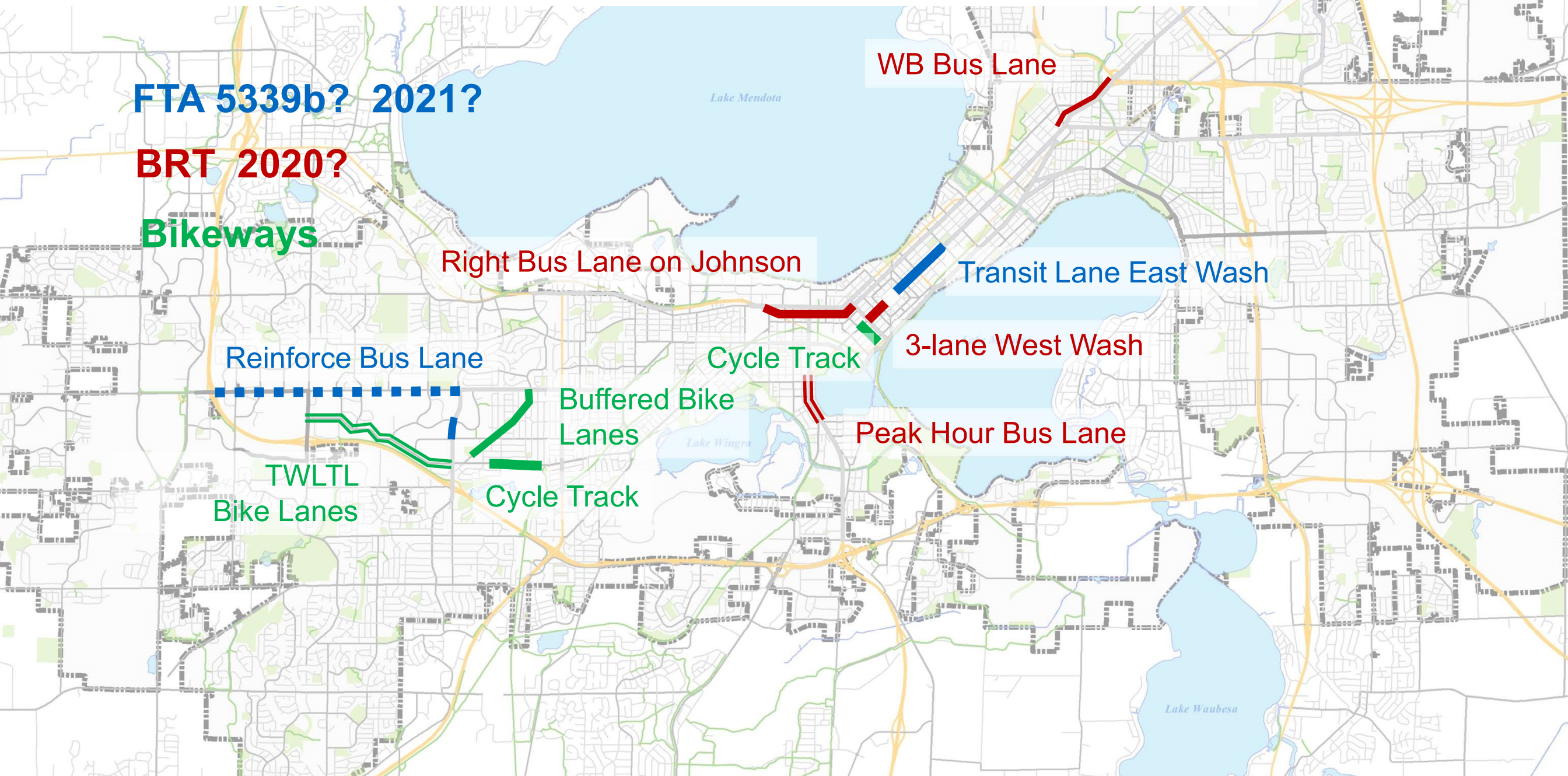
- **VMT is at it's lowest as it has been in decades**

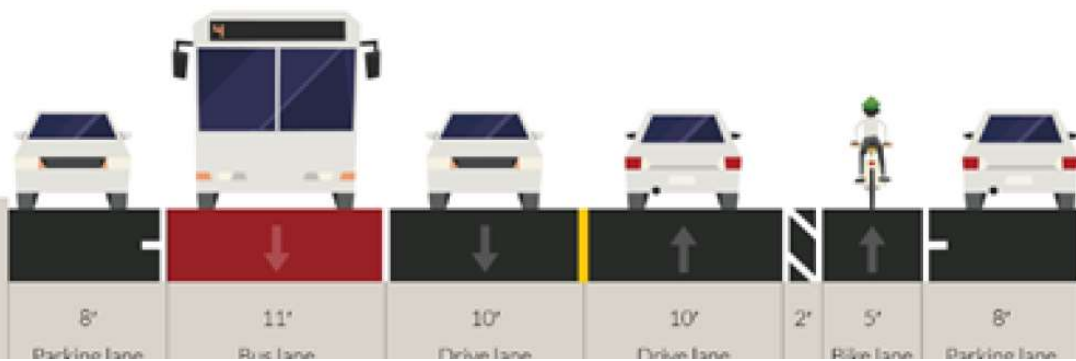

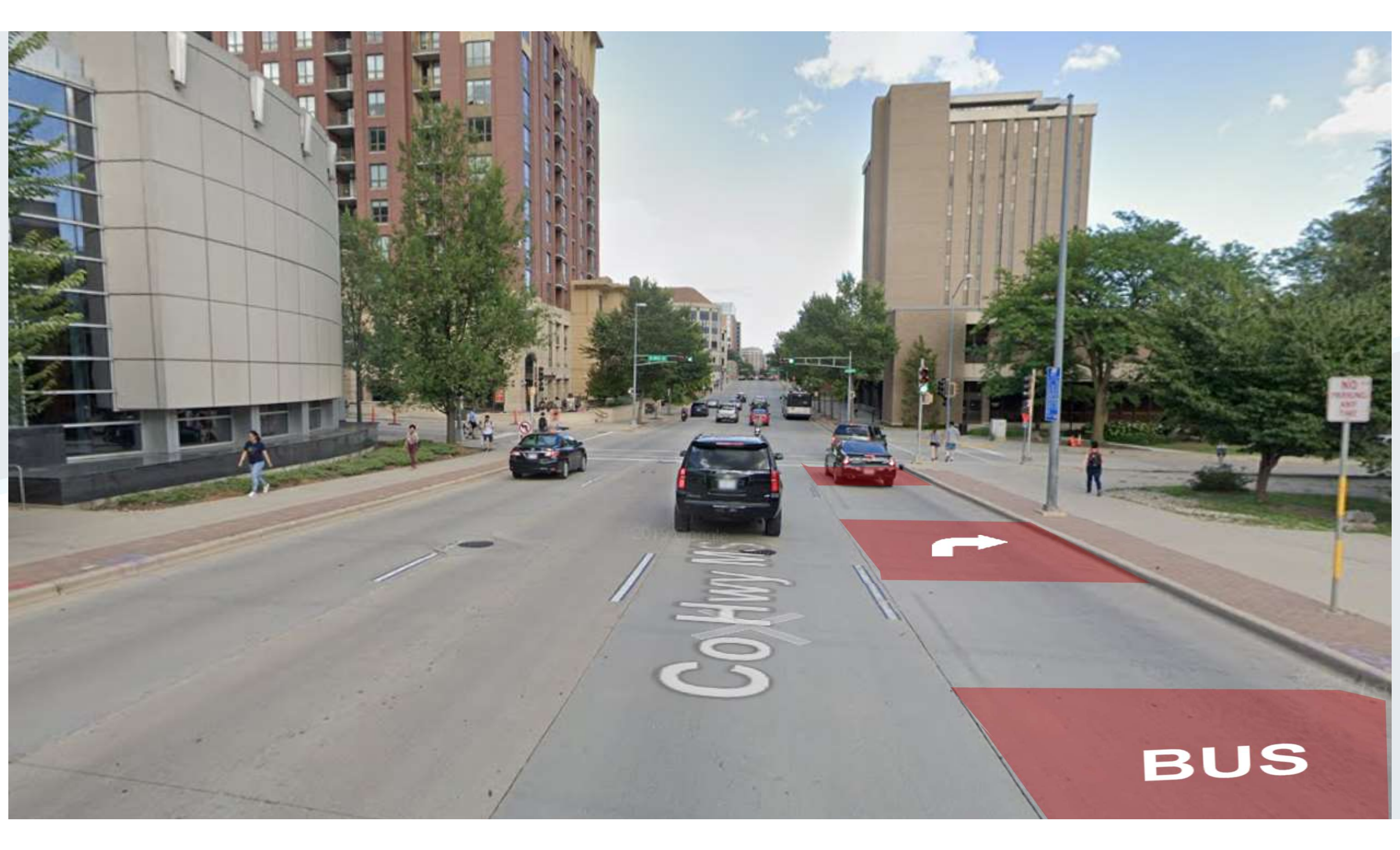

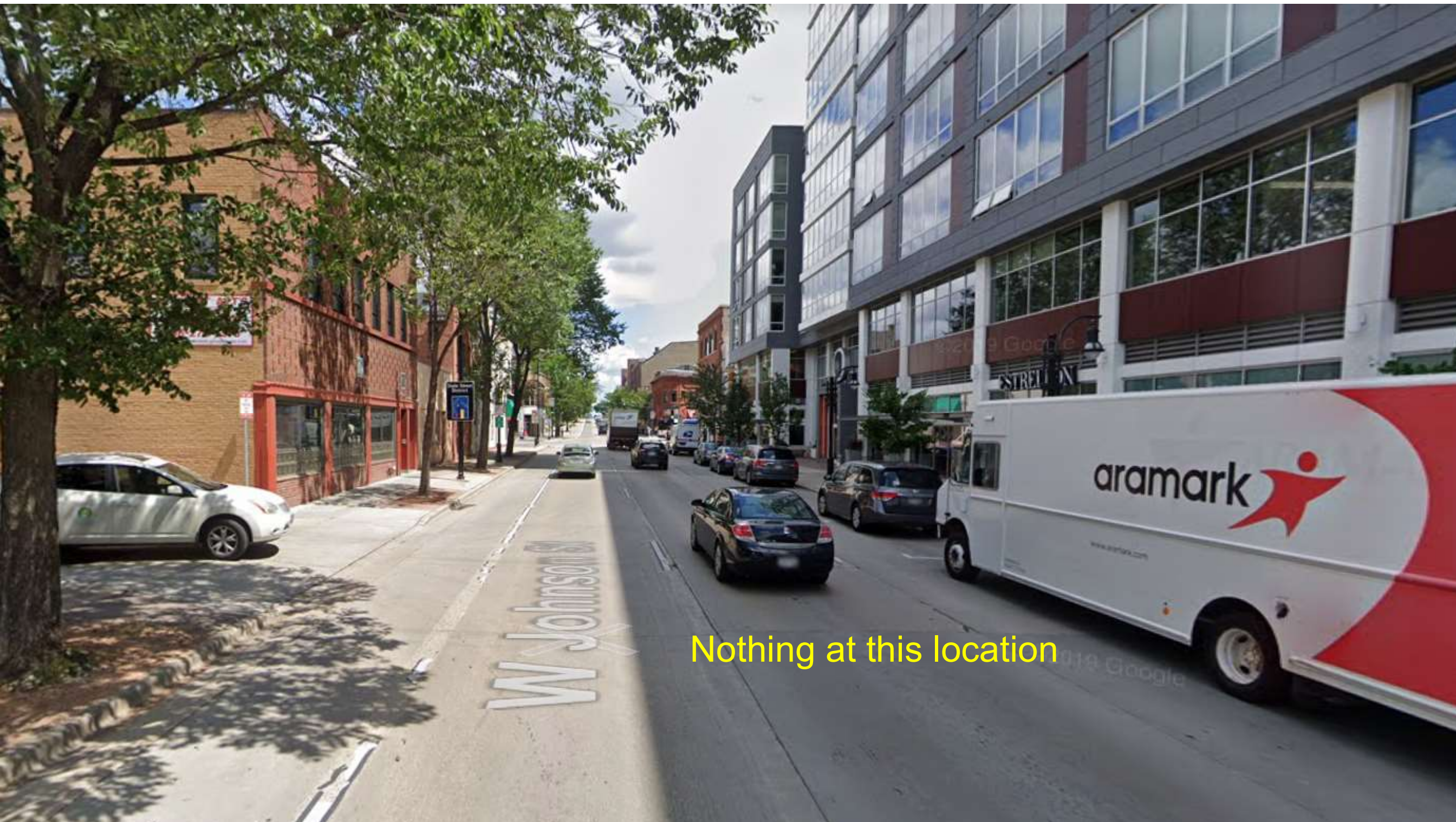
