The City is proposing construction of the Central Park project, an urban park located in the East Isthmus Corridor on the near east side. The City has received approximately \$3.1 million from a Federal grant for the construction and land acquisition for this project. The initial construction of the Park will be broken into 2 phases. Phase 1A was constructed in 2013 and Phase 1B will be constructed in 2014. Funding for the construction of Phase 1B of this project is included in the 2014 Adopted Capital Budget and the 2014 Executive Capital Budget as Recommended by the Board of Estimates

The Skatepark-Central Park, Madison project includes the construction of the City's first skatepark. Construction is anticipated to start in July 2014 with substantial completion in the fall. Estimated cost of this project is \$750,000.00.
