SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS

Jewish Social Services provides a designated nutrition site with our popular weekly Lechayim Lunchtime Plus program. From September through May, Lechayim offers an affordable kosher meal, yoga from a chair, and wonderful educational presentations and entertainment.

The JSS chaplain and volunteers bring Senior Shabbat gatherings to several retirement residences, featuring candle lightning, challah, wine, lots of music and singing and a Torah discussion. You do not need to be Jewish or live in the residence to attend.

Programming for Russian Seniors includes a Hanukkah party and affordable or complementary tickets to cultural events of special interest.
